## Adventure, training free with Cadets

You don't have to be planning a career with the military to get involved with army cadets in Milton.

Cadets develop skills that will be useful no matter what path they take in life, says Phillip Seaborne-Davies, commanding officer of the 2990 Royal Canadian Army Cadet Corps which meets at Milton District High School.

"The military is a very good teacher," vows the British army veteran.

Army cadets receive survival training — learning how to live off the land, camping and mapping skills. Leadership and teamwork are emphasized.

"They're as good as any regular force soldiers," said Mr. Seaborne-Davies.

Open to young people between the ages of 12 and 18 years, the program costs nothing to join. It is supported by the Royal Canadian Legion and the Department of National Defence.

The corps' mandate is to represent citizenship, physical fitness, and promote the Canadian Armed Forces, he added.

About 15 youths are currently members of the Milton corps, and the commanding officer is hoping to attract more.
