Peel Selects win juvenile gold

Hamilton was the host city for the Ontario Volleyball Association's Juvenile Women's Tier One Challenge Cup recently.

Both of the Peel Selects juvenile women's teams participated with the Maroon squad claiming gold.

In pool play the two Peel sides faced each other along with teams from Hamilton and Kitchener-Waterloo. The Maroon Selects finished first in pool play, going undefeated in the round robin portion.

The Grey Selects finished fourth in pool play. They went on to meet the Stratford Stingers and the Kitchener-Waterloo Tigers to complete the day with a seventh place finish.

The Maroon squad defeated the Toronto Titans in the first round of the playoff and then advanced to defeat the Toronto Eclipse team in the gold medal match.

A tough month of practicing lies ahead for both teams as the Provincial Cup for the juvenile age group is scheduled April 11-12 in Midland. The Provincial Cup for the junior division is scheduled for Scarborough on April 4, a tournament the Maroon team will play.

A gold medal in these tournaments leads to the national level in May with the team representing Ontario. The same road exists for the Selects midget team who will compete in their Provincial Cup on April 4-5 in Oakville.

Register for Appleby sports

Appleby College's summer sports program is gearing up for its third season once again offering hockey, tennis, soccer and a general sports slate. Both hockey and tennis are also offered at the advanced level.

The school operates at capacity most weeks with the emphasis on learning the sports rather than just playing the games. The full time programs are full-day affairs run on a weekly basis and are staffed by adult professional coaches.

All head instructors from last season are back: Kevin Grant (soccer), John Bassett (tennis), David Suchanek (exploring sports) and David Jenner (hockey).

The college facilities are used and include: a regulation sized arena, seven full sized playing fields, 25 metre indoor pool, 9,000 square foot gymnasium, softball diamonds, tennis courts, infirmary, athletic therapy centre, weight rooms, classrooms and dining halls.

Hockey features 2.5 hours of ice time daily in two sessions, goaltending instruction, groups by age and ability, video instruction, t-shirt and awards. Cost is \$199 per week with additional weeks for \$150.

Tennis features entry level to intermediate instruction, video instruction, guest instructors, etiquette, t-shirt and awards. The cost is the same as hockey.

Soccer offered many of the same features as the other sports and costs \$119 per week. The exploring sports program includes a variety of activities like soccer, volleyball, swimming, softball and basketball. The cost is \$179 per week. Sessions run from late June to the end of August.

All regular hockey sessions still have openings. The June 29-July 3 session of tennis is full but other tennis sessions are open.
