Appeal to breathe funds into asthma programs

Funds raised will assist the Air Force Asthma Program which is designed for both parents and children has helped thousands of families to manage this disease more effectively.

The appeal has as its representative eight-year-old Derek, an asthma sufferer. At age four he was rushed to the hospital because he could not breathe. In 1988 he met with a near fatal attack. Today his asthma is under control. He and his mother now believe they have gained a better understanding of the lung disease and its management through the Air Force program.

"Please support the Lung Association's 1992 Asthma Appeal. Funds raised through this campaign will be used in this community to help asthmatic children breathe easier," concluded Dr. Haddon.

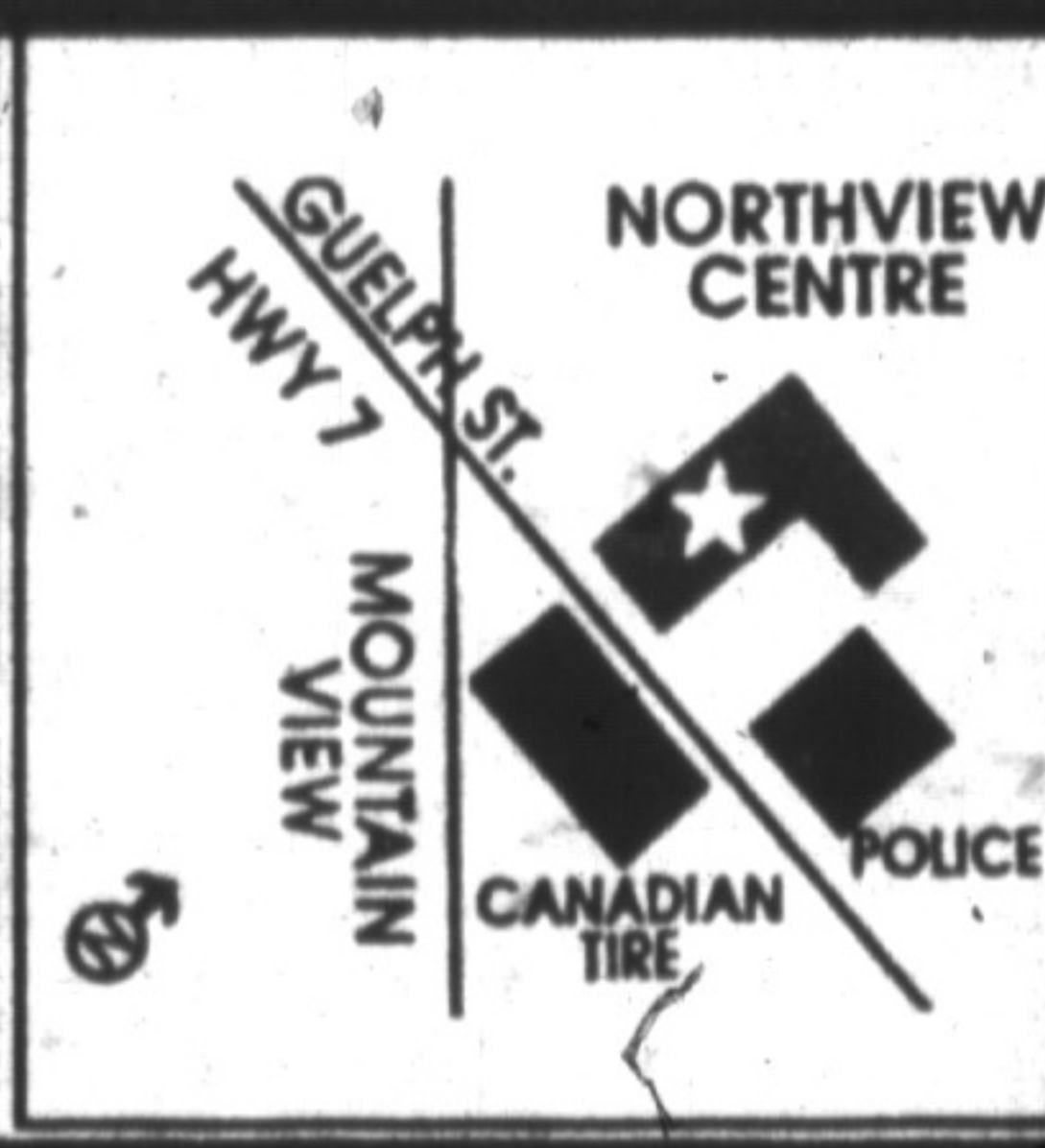
