The Salvation Army's presence in Milton will go beyond its food bank, thrift store and collection kettles to include a place of worship beginning this Sunday.


April 12 will be the first service at E. C. Drury School for the Deaf auditorium led by husband and wife David and Beth Pearo. The Palm Sunday service will begin at 10:30 a.m. as will all subsequent Sunday services.

The Salvation Army is an evangelical church. According to its leaders, music and informality along with basic Christian ideas for daily living are stressed. Nursery and child care are provided and the coffee pot will be on.

The couple leading the church are both students of the Salvation Army College for Officer Training in Toronto and will be ordained this June. David obtained his bachelor of theology degree at Ontario Bible College in 1986 and went on to earn his master of theological studies degree at the Ontario Theological Seminary. Beth's background includes a bachelor of arts degree in psychology from the University of Alberta and a bachelor of education degree from Mount Saint Vincent University in Halifax. Before committing to full time service for the Salvation Army, Beth taught elementary school at Stouffville, Ontario.

The couple have one child, Jessica. The pastoral team say they are committed to "making the Bible come alive" and keeping their teachings "relevant".


