He hoped no dramatic expansion of Phoenix would mean there would be less property available to sell to the cemetery. Besides, Mr. Downs added, "I'm sure the neighbours would prefer" living next door to a

cemetery over residing beside an industry of some sort.

Various councillors expressed reservations about just how the matter will eventually turn out, in view of the fact the current business use could change over time, but they supported the rezoning. There will, however, be conditions set on any possible expansion.

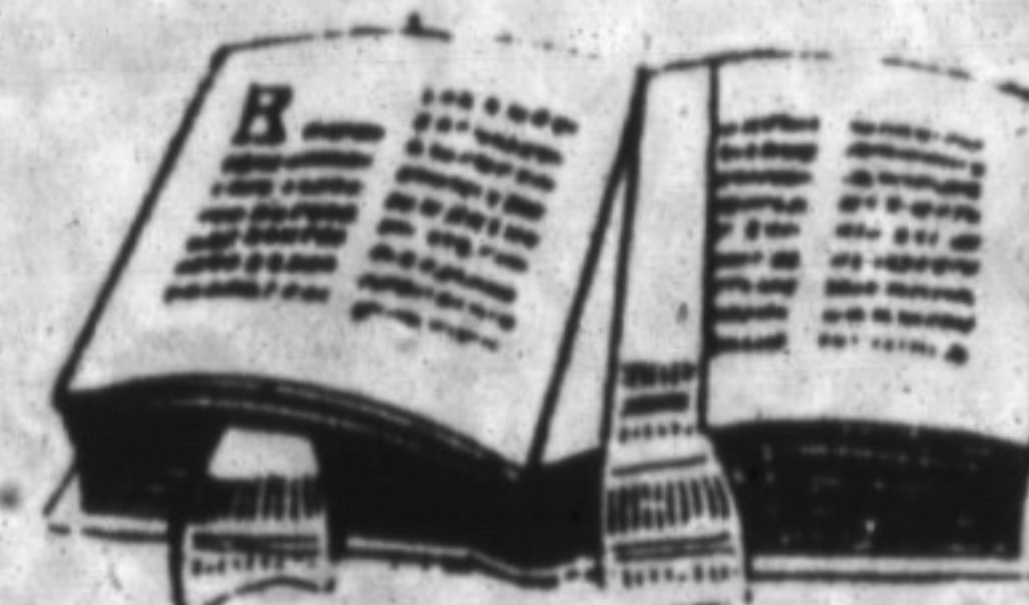
