before," he added. "People will see some events they might not ever see."

An American company, New York Bungee Adventures Inc., will offer the courageous bungee jumping for \$80 a leap. Participants must be 18 years of age, but must not be under the influence of alcohol, and not weigh more than 240 pounds.

A CHAM radio disc jockey has agreed to take the plunge Friday evening between 3 and 9 p.m. during the Hamilton station's live broadcast from the stampepe.

While most of the action gets underway Friday and Saturday, opening-day Wednesday will feature chuckwagon races at 7 p.m. and a fireworks display at 10 p.m.

The chuckwagon races, a subject of controversy by animal rights activists, will continue Thursday, Friday, and Saturday nights.

The Lions Club has hired a veterinarian who will be on site during the races following concern expressed by area humane societies that the activity threatens the safety of the horses.

The Six Nation Indian Reserve will put on a show Friday at 6:30 p.m. and Saturday at 2 p.m. The weekend events will also include a re-enactment of the War of 1812 at 1 p.m. Saturday, and 3 and 5 p.m. Saturday and Sunday.

Local firefighters will get in on the action as well with water cannon fights at 3 p.m. Saturday and 2 p.m. Sunday.

While previously-announced helicopter rides have been cancelled, the latest addition to the stampepe is barrel racing which gets underway at 3:30 p.m. Saturday.

Conklin shows, bungee jumping, and the Buckle Rodeo — a mock rodeo-adventure featuring teams of five people performing various feats with stuffed toy horses and bulls — will take place daily.

A sports card show will be held Saturday and Sunday, and the OPP will perform a radar demonstration with proceeds to Halton Women's Place.

The usual carnival-type activities — clowns, face painting, pony rides, and food concessions — will also be on hand.

And for those wishing to be musically entertained, country and western band Blue Water Country of Stoney Creek will perform Friday and Saturday nights from 8:30 to 11:30.

Lions members are vying to raise more than \$25,000 for the organization, which annually supports local causes such as the Salvation Army, Scouts, Halton Centennial Manor, and amateur sporting events.

"I'm hopeful people will recognize the good things the Lions Club does," Mr. Klingender added. "All the money (raised) is going back into the community."

Admission costs \$5 for adults and \$3 for children aged 7 to 12 years. Kids under 7 years of age will be admitted free.
