# **Gypsy Moth Public Information Session**

The Region of Halton and the Halton Region Conservation Authority are conducting a public information session about Gypsy Moths. The Gypsy Moth caterpillar feeds on the foliage of most trees and can be a serious pest to deciduous species. In Halton, Gypsy Moth infestations have occurred mainly in wood lots south of Highway 5.

The Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources has cancelled the 1992 Gypsy Moth Aerial Spraying Program. The purpose of this information centre is to provide land owners in Halton with information on individual control methods for Gypsy Moth infestations. A presentation will begin at 7:15 p.m. and staff will be in attendance to answer questions.
