**Students shine**

Nine E.C. Drury High School students recently showed off their brain power in the Canadian Academic Decathlon.

Following four months of intensive preparation, the team placed third in the national competition.

The top three scores were too close for comfort. The top team scored 38,803 compared with Drury's 38,024. The team was made up of three students with "A" averages, three with "B" averages, and three with "C" averages over the last two years.

Drury won a total of 14 individual gold, silver, and bronze medals in nine of the 10 events.

The students won the following awards: Tammy Crewson (bronze medal in speeches); and Tracey Ellison (silver in social science, bronze in essay writing, gold in fine arts, gold in language and literature, third-place "B" student).

Heather Fleming (silver in essay writing, fourth-place "A" student); and Laura Franklin and Kevin Gale (bronze in social science, gold in interview, and bronze in speeches).

Todd Jaques (bronze in social sciences); Javed Mirza (bronze in math), silver in economics); Jason Robar (bronze in mathematics).
