Trucks to test their strength at fairgrounds

Some trucks pull their weight better than others and on Saturday, June 20, a competition at Milton Fair Grounds will separate the leaders from the followers when it comes to torque and horsepower.

The Halton Agricultural Society will host the Milton Truck Pull as a fundraiser to help pay the costs of their new office building. The pre-

vious structure burned to the ground last September. The agricultural society is the group that runs the annual fall fair.

Some sturdy trucks should take the field at the fairgrounds. The event is sanctioned by the Central Ontario Truck Pull Association. As far as the competitors go, "most of them are regulars," said Charlie Speck, who is helping organize the competition. So their vehicles are expected to be up to the task of hauling sled loads of concrete down a straightaway.

There are three classes of four-wheel drive pulls as well as an event featuring highway-type tractor trailers, Mr. Speck said.

People who want to compete as walk-ons can do so, too, provided their trucks meet basic requirements, Mr. Speck added.

There will be a set of scales on site to help separate the trucks by weight.
