Arson cause of blazes

Halton Regional Police and Crime Stoppers are appealing to the public for information that will lead to the arrest of the person or persons responsible for damage to new houses at a construction site, where arson is responsible for an estimated \$1 million.

On Saturday, June 13 at approximately 3:10 a.m. residents on Heidi Avenue near Cleaver Avenue in Burlington were awakened by a fire at a house under construction. The Fire Department and Halton Police responded to the scene.

The fire originated at lot 21 but due to strong winds it spread to three other houses. As a result hundreds of area residents were evacuated as the fires raged on.

While members of the Burlington Fire Department were battling the fires at lot 21 and the adjacent building, they were alerted to a second fire at lot 15. This fire was six lots east of lot 21.

The fires have been investigated by the Fire Marshalls office and both have been determined to have been deliberately set.

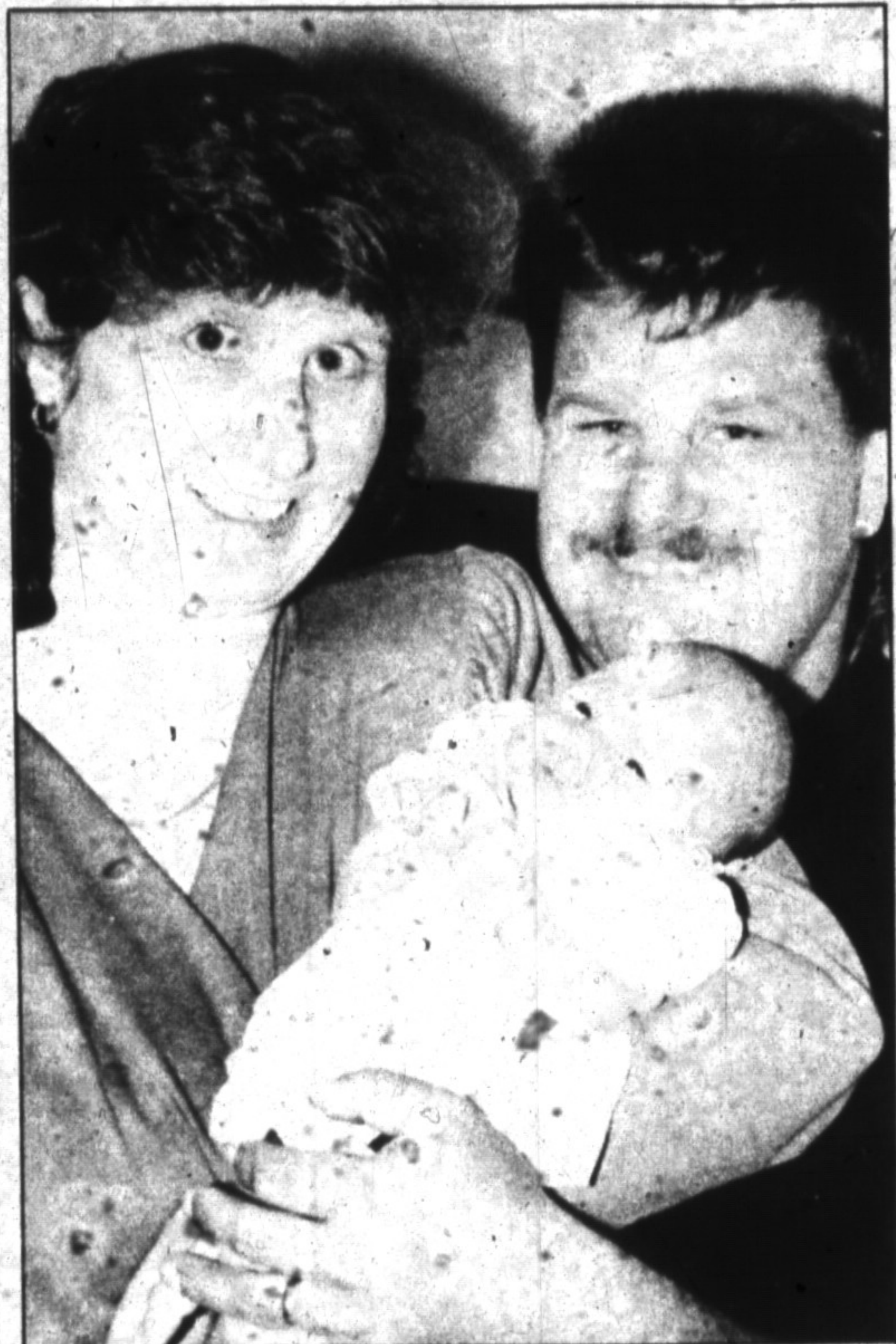
