

Donation at annual meeting to buy mammography unit

A \$60,000 donation presented at the Milton District Hospital Board's 32nd annual meeting has made possible the purchase of a mammography unit for the hospital.

The money was raised by the hospital auxiliary and brought the total donated by the group for this specific purchase to more than the \$100,000 actual cost. A round of applause from the capacity crowd at the recent meeting was the reaction to the announcement made by Betty Nisbet, president of the Milton District Hospital Auxiliary. A meeting which served to recognize long-term service of hospital staff also covered some more serious matters.

In her report, board chair Carole Budworth noted the future of all hospitals will not be an easy one but she said, "I am confident the people directing the course of Milton District Hospital will ensure continued success as a major provider of health care in our community."

She recognized the dedication of her fellow board members and cited new members Sheldon Wolfson, elected in 1991; Dickie Deumer, auxiliary representative and Drs. Ken Bradley and Lynne Robinson for their contributions.

The organizers of the third annual Wellness Fair were praised by the

outgoing chair who has completed six years service with the board. Her complements were passed onto the auxiliary and hospital Foundation members for their "tireless enthusiasm and dedication" to the hospital.

The traditional staff recognition drew special attention to Dr. Ivan Hunter. For his 25 years service he received a pin and an engraved silver tray. A total of 46 people were eligible for long service awards for five, 10, 15, 20 and 25 years. Margot Johnson and Margaret Sime were given their pins plus special gifts for their 20 years of service.

Elected to their second three-year terms at the annual general meeting were Vera Delacourt and Carol Chudleigh. Norm Flemington, owner of Sherman Sand and Gravel and Bill Choma, Chief Financial Officer of Milton Hydro were elected to their first terms.

Members of the executive of the Hospital Board for 1992-1993 are: Chuck Copeland, chair; Peter McCuaig, vice-chair; and Matt Jaecklein, treasurer.

Amendments to the Corporation's bylaws included a new bylaw which requires nominations for positions on the Board of directors be submitted at least 30 days before the annual meeting.
