out approximately \$25 million in welfare payments in 1992 if all goes as predicted. The provincial and federal governments fund 80 per cent of that. Halton's predicted share, therefore, is roughly \$5 million, with potential for a \$250,000 shortfall.

In June Halton paid \$2,245 (including provincial-federal contributions) to welfare recipients, down from \$2,270,000 in May and \$2,313,990 in April. In March, the peak month, Halton gave out \$2,419,019.

As the recession worsened, regional statistics illustrate the fact that more and more people capable of working were forced onto social assistance, usually as their unemployment benefits ran out.

This June, for exapmle, a full 73 per cent of welfare cases involved people deemed to be capable of working. In June of 1991 that figure was almost 13 per cent less, at 60.4 per cent. In June of 1990 less than half of welfare recipients (46.4 per cent) were judged capable of holding a job.

In January of 1990 there were 1,258 welfare cases in Halton. That number climbed steadily and topped 3,000 in December of 1991.


