Shops get vacation from holiday closings

Despite the objections of Burlington regional councillor Ralph Scholtens, Halton regional council has approved holiday shopping permits for six tourism-oriented business centres in Oakville, Burlington and Halton Hills. Although Sunday shopping became a reality again in early June across Ontario, merchants must still apply for permission to open on

statutory holidays. The six applicants considered that important enough to submit a \$1,000 fee to Halton for the permits. Burlington's Village Square shopping complex, the Bronte area in Oakville, and four Halton Hills businesses related to Acton's leather-hospitality industry controlled by Steve Dawkins obtained the permits, good for all statutory holidays except Christmas Day.

"I'm not going to be voting in favour of this," Mr. Scholtens said at regional council last Wednesday. Mr. Scholtens has indicated in the past he is troubled by Sunday shopping, as well as this latest move to allow openings on religious holidays.

From a purely economic standpoint, Mr. Scholtens argued, "before Sunday shopping we were led to believe" it would end the recession. "Lo and behold, the recession is still here."

There are many "businesses that don't want to be open for religious reasons" on Sundays and some statutory holidays. I respect that," the councillor said. "I do believe there should be a protection in place for those people."

Oakville Mayor Ann Mulvale, who does not favour Sunday shopping, said that "wider issue" was not the one before council last Wednesday. Rather, the choice to be made was whether the businesses applying deserved tourism-oriented holiday opening permits.

Speaking in support of the applicants, Halton Hills councillor Rick Bonnette said, "every one of these stores does rely on tourism."
