Confederation Cup final on Sunday

Some of North America's best three-year-old pacing colts will be at Flamboro Downs for the Confederation Cup on Sunday.

A record 118 pacers were nominated for the \$350,000 (estimated) race back on March 15. On May 15 a \$1,500 sustaining fee was due and 68 owners stayed in the race for the Cup.

The most notable pacer is Western Hanover, owned by George Segal of Kentucky and trained by Gene Riegle has won seven times in 12 races in 1992. As a two-year-old, Western Hanover had a mark of 1:52.1 and banked \$697,332. This season the horse has raced to \$810,212 and has established a new mark of 1:50.4. With just over \$1.5 million in lifetime earnings the horse is the richest Cup eligible.

Other top pacers include: Admirals Galley, Big Brat, Bruce My Boy, Caprock, Driven By Design, Shipps Saint, and Shore Patrol.

Arcane Hanover captured the 1991 Confederation Cup with a new track and Canadian record of 1:53.2 in front of 7,288 fans.

According to officials of the Cup. one of the jewels in what has been described as the 'Canadian Triple Crown' it is every bit as demanding as its sister races The North American Cup and the Prix d'ete. It is contested in one day of fierce competition including heats and finals on a banked half-mile oval.
