Helping kids organize: How to turn clean-up into child's play

If your child's room resembles a construction zone, with toys strewn all over the floor and dirty clothes stuffed under the bed, you're not alone. Convincing children to clean their rooms can be one of the most difficult

To help children organize and display their favorite things, DeJulio suggests putting the walls to work with easy-to-install decorative shelving. "Of course, installing shelving is no guarantee that you will be able to see what color the carpet is in your child's room, but it will greatly increase your child's storage area," explains DeJulio.

When selecting shelving, look for attractive, well-crafted shelving units that will blend in with the child's style in decor, suggests DeJulio. "Products such as Knape & Vogt's Variations*

white unit is a wise choice, because it allows you to paint the standards and brackets to match any color scheme." And Variations shelves are reinforced with steel rails and optional bookend brackets to keep heavy items and books in their place.

Shelving can even serve as a small work area or vanity when installed at desk height. "Hang a mirror above a bottom shelf, and little girls have a place to dress up and put on jewelry, just like their favorite movie star," explains DeJulio.

DeJulio also recommends installing shelving at child height, so that favorite toys and storytime books can go on lower shelves within easy reach. Keep fragile items, like porcelain dolls or prized trophies, on the highest shelves, out of reach," advises DeJulio.

The Variations wall template, a sewing pattern-like aid that is taped on the wall to assist with pre-installation placement, provides shelving height recommendations for youngsters. "The template is especially popular with sin-gle parents who want to install shelving on their own," explains DeJulio.

Whether you're a veteran do-it-yourselfer or a rookie, installing shelving in a child's room - or any other room is a practical solution to controlling clutter, says DeJulio. "It's attractive, affordable and easy to install - but, best of all, it's a solution that may just make parenting a bit easier."


