Bank robber has tattoo

A man entered the Bank of Montreal at Appleby Mall at 5111 New Street in Burlington August 31, and presented a note to tellers advising them of the robbery.

Two tellers were ordered to comply with demands for cash and the robber left the bank. He was seen getting into a blue or grey Chevette, driven by a second man.

The suspect is described as male, white, 20 to 30 years of age, 5'6" to 5'10" tall. He had short, reddish, sandy brown hair and a couple of days growth of beard.

He has a tattoo on his left forearm, described as green and black, an intricate pattern, and appeared to be an old tattoo.

He was wearing a white painter style cap with a Hamilton Tiger Cat logo on it, dark sunglasses, blue jeans, and a brownish coloured lumber jacket.
