Special events include guided walks, bird banding and live birds of prey demonstrations. All activities are free with admission.

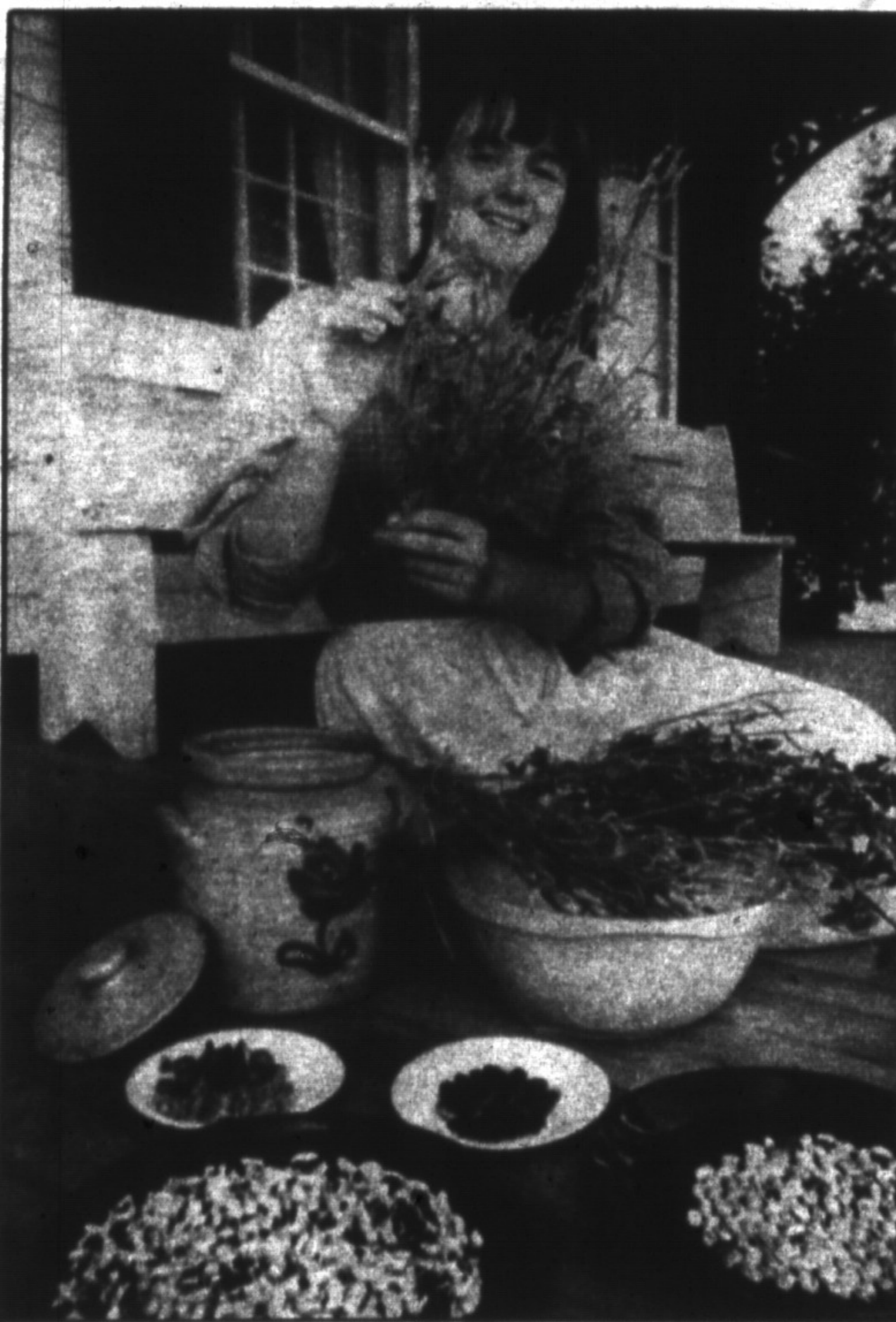

Christmas comes here this weekend

A spectrum of Canadian country crafts returns to the Ontario Agricultural Museum for the 9th annual Christmas Craft Fair, Saturday and Sunday, September 19-20 from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.

More than 50 exhibitors from throughout the province will offer original designs in knits, wood, jewellery, folk art, stained glass, quilts, pottery and more—all hand-made by artisans.

"The Craft Fair's Country Christmas theme appeals to both the urban and rural communities, making it an extremely successful event," says the museum general manager, John Wiley.

Held in the museum's Gambrel Barn with its rustic allure of hand-hewn timbers, this event continues to grow in popularity. A second building is used to include additional crafts.

While taking in this event, visitors can also view the popular Ontario Agricultural Museum Quilt Collection in its new permanent gallery at the museum.

Discover more than 30 buildings and displays on the museum's 32-hectare site. Costumed interpreters, farm animals, wagon rides and a gift shop are all part of the experience.

The museum, located on Town Line (Tremaine Road) just south of Hwy 401, is open daily 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Admission is \$3.50 for adults, \$1.75 for youths (6-17 yrs) or seniors, and \$8.50 for a family.

TSN crew rolls into dealership

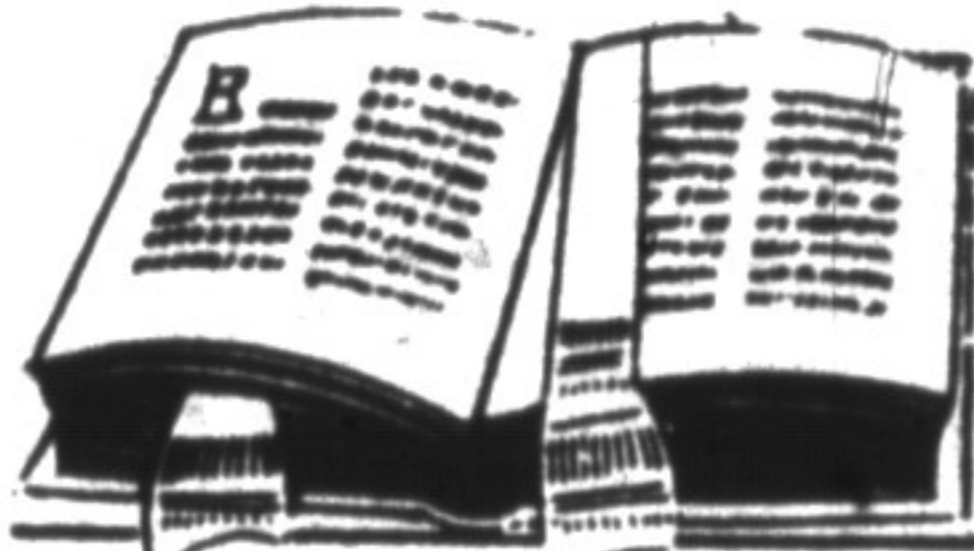

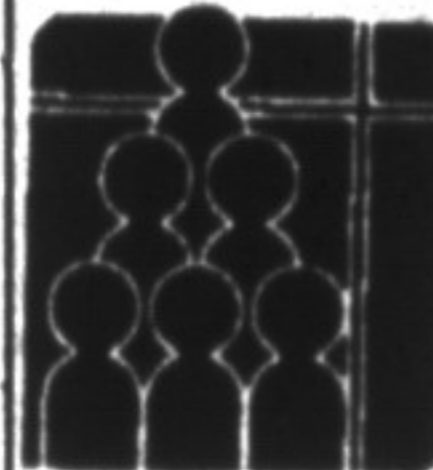
