Julian Reed back in political saddle

Norval resident Julian Reed will

be the Halton-Peel candidate in the next federal election. Mr. Reed, the former Liberal MPP

for Halton-Burlington, was acclaimed at a nomination meeting of the Federal Liberal Party Association of Halton-Peel held at Georgetown Friday evening.

About 70 Liberal supporters attended the meeting including two of Mr. Reed's former provincial government colleagues who held minister's positions under David Peterson, John Eakins, former minister of tourism and recreation and Vince Kerrio, former minister of energy and natural resources.

No stranger to politics, the 56-year-old served as MPP for Halton-Burlington from 1975 to 1985. He also worked as executive assistant to Mr. Kerrio from 1985 to 1987.

Mr. Reed, who has spent the past few years re-establishing his acting career, farming and developing Reed Energy Corporation, says he did a lot of thinking before he decided to re-enter politics.

A meeting with federal Liberal party leader Jean Chrétien, helped him make his decision. Mr. Reed says he came away from that meeting with the impression there was no one more committed to Canada than Mr. Chrétien.

The federal election candidate predicts a federal vote won't take place until sometime in 1993. Campaigns, he says, likely won't start until after the Oct. 26 referendum on the Constitution.

"In terms of organization we (the local Liberals) are not in bad shape," says Mr. Reed.

If Progressive Conservative MP Garth Turner decides to run again, Mr. Reed will be squaring off against him.

"If he does (run), it will be a very difficult campaign," says Mr. Reed. "He's the incumbent and that will give him a real advantage. I think his weakest point is his boss (Mulroney)."

Mr. Reed says if the unity issue is resolved, the economy will be the big question in the next election.

"It will be a bread and butter election. The economy has been put on the back burner. We are going to have to face a \$420 billion national debt."

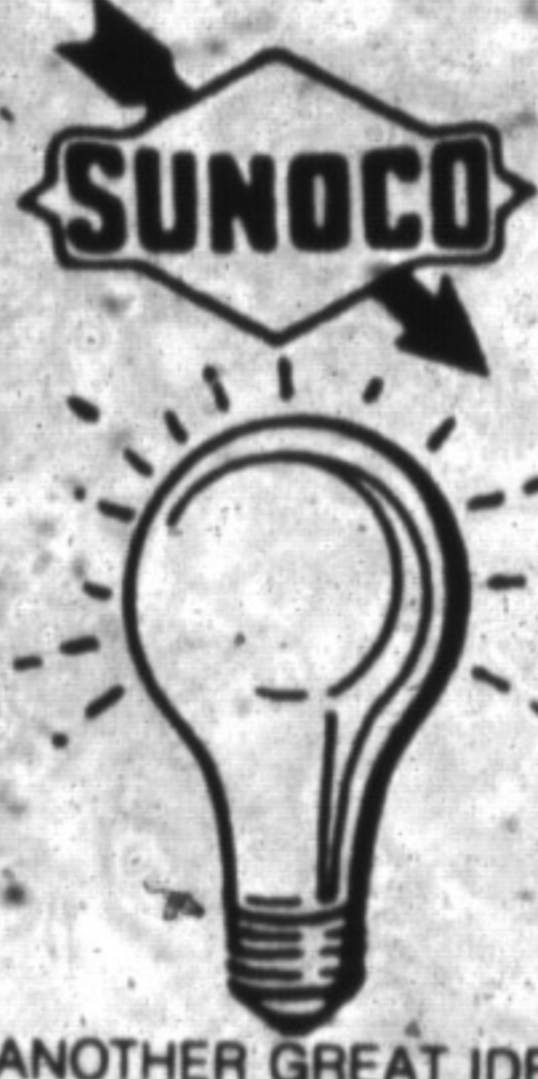
Free trade will also be part of the debate, he says.

"The Liberal party and I concur, while we support the principle of free trade, we don't agree with the free trade agreements."
