

Thieves lift guitars from car at apartment complex

About \$5,700 worth of guitars and equipment were stolen from a car in a smash and grab overnight Sept. 22. The culprits broke a window of a Honda Civic parked at the apartment building at 122 Bronte St. and stole the instruments as well as an amplifier. The guitars, which went missing sometime between 12:30 and 8 a.m., were stored in brown and black cases.

Stolen truck recovered

A trailer left parked at Fifth Wheel Truck Stop for a month turned out to be stolen from Peel region.

Worth about \$12,000, the vehicle's Ontario licence plates had been changed to Michigan plates, police said.

At the time of the theft, the trailer was loaded with flashlights and lanterns which police believe were sold by the culprits at Toronto-area flea markets.

A group of suspected thieves from Toronto are believed to be responsible for stealing the trailer.

They have been charged in connection with the incident.

Woman assaulted in her apartment

An Ontario Street woman's common-law husband has been charged with assault after the woman was struck across the face Saturday night.

The couple, who decided to separate, were having an argument at the time of the assault, regional police said.

A man grabbed the woman's face, police said. She broke free by biting the attacker.

A 53-year-old man, also of Ontario Street, has been charged. He'll appear in Milton provincial court Oct. 19.

Teen brawlers at fall fair

Fights involving teenagers broke out at Milton Fair Grounds Friday and Sunday nights, say police.

Charges were pending yesterday following a scuffle between three girls Sunday on the grounds.

A Milton girl was assaulted by two other female youths who confronted the victim at 6 p.m., police said. The 17-year-old girl was pushed and punched in the head resulting in

minor cuts and bruises to her face.

A fight also broke out at the midway during the Milton Fall Fair Friday night.

The Halton Agricultural Society, which organized the fair, hired police to patrol the three-day event.

"There was some rumbling going on, but it was covered by police," said Marjorie Hall, secretary-treasurer of the organization.
