Italian Basil Loaf

A light-as-a-feather loaf with the flavour of basil and Parmesan cheese.

- Makes two round loaves.
- 5 cups (1,250 ml) all purpose flour;
- 2 envelopes Fleischmann's Quick-Rise Instant Yeast*;
- 1/2 cup (125 ml) grated Parmesan cheese;

- 1/2 tsp (2 ml) salt;
- 1 1/4 cup (300 ml) water;
- 1/3 cup (75 ml) olive oil or vegetable oil;
- 1/2 cup (125 ml) finely chopped fresh basil (or 3 tbsp/45 ml dried);
- 2 eggs, beaten;

Directions: Reserve 1 cup (250 ml) flour. In large mixing bowl, combine 4 cups (1 L) flour, undissolved yeast, Parmesan cheese and salt.

Heat water and oil until very warm, 125°F - 130°F (50°C - 55°C). Stir in basil. Stir warm liquids into dry mixture; stir in eggs. Stir batter vigorously, until well mixed. Gradually add enough reserved flour to form a soft ball of dough. Turn out onto floured surface.

Knead (with reserved flour) until dough is smooth and elastic, for about 8-10 minutes. Cover, let rest 10 minutes.

Divide dough in half. Form each half into a round loaf. Cut an X about 1/4 inch (6mm) deep in centre of each loaf and place on greased baking sheets. Lightly dust loaves with flour. Cover, let rise until double in size (about 30-40 min). Bake at 375°F (190°C) 25-30 minutes or until brown. Cool on wire racks.

* 1-8g envelope = about 1 tbsp (15 ml).
