**Computer courses for UIC recipients**

Sixteen Milton unemployment insurance recipients will hopefully be plugging into a brighter future through a computer skills course taught by the Halton Board of Education.  
The board's Adult Computer Training Centre will open Tuesday (Oct. 13) at Towne Square in downtown Milton. Four classes of approximately 15 students are expected to take part in the program, new to this area, over the next year.  
The participants were picked by the Milton Canada Employment Centre, which funds the initiative. They're chosen because of their likelihood to succeed in the 12-week program, said Jamie Elchuk, the course co-ordinator for the Halton board.  
"It's basically training sessions from 9 (a.m.) to 4 (p.m.), Monday to Friday," Mr. Elchuk said. The sessions comprise 300 hours of computer and life skills training, as well as a six-week work placement.  
Mr. Elchuk said the course tends to build the self-esteem of unemployed people, as well as giving them new job skills. "They look at it as a job. There's nothing like having somewhere to go in the morning."  
The courses have been run in Burlington for some time but are novel in Milton. Computer applications such as WordPerfect and Lotus 1-2-3 will be taught, as well as other skills. "They come out with a lot of knowledge," Mr. Elchuk said.

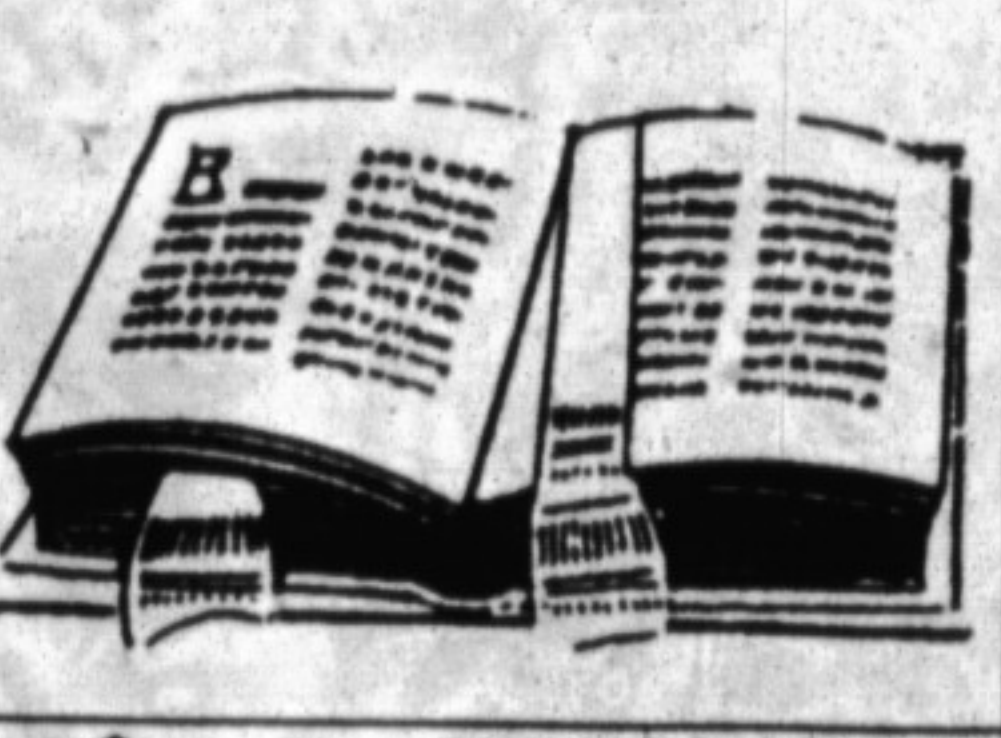
