

# Fillies dazzle in Harvest Stakes at Mohawk Saturday

Twenty-four fabulous two-year-old pacing fillies contested three divisions of the Harvest Stakes Oct. 17 at Mohawk.

The first split worth \$87,017 went to the talented Sonsam filly Simcha. Driven by Doug Brown for trainer Phil Coole, Simcha equalled her lifetime speed mark of 1:56 3/5.

Racing on the outside for much of the mile, Simcha wore down the stubborn pace-setting China Flower by a head. Klipper Wilco was third.

"She raced just super," praised Brown. "I was planning on leaving with her but Phil (trainer Phil Coole) told me she races better with cover, but the way it went I never ended up

getting any."

A \$10,000 yearling purchase, Simcha pushed her season earnings to just shy of \$100,000 for owners Tony Delmonte, Don Murray, Chico Sernaglia and Gabe Piscelli.

The second division provided another thrilling finish with Towners Image popping out of the pocket to win in a stunning 1:55 3/5 for reinsman Tim Twaddle. The daughter of Big Towner upset favourites

Topaz Blue and Incredible Way.

In his typical manner, Twaddle was quick to credit others with the success. "Her caretaker Paul Manna deserves a lot of credit. He's done a great job looking after her and Burnsie (trainer John Burns) has kept her well-conditioned. I just drive."

Towners Image, now a winner of \$129,789 is owned by Burns, Keith Waples and Martwest Racing Stable of Mississauga.

If you could see me now had Mohawk spectators take notice of more than

just her name in the final division with a gate to wire 1:56 effort for Roger Mayotte. It was the third win in just six career starts for the Jate Lobell miss who's trained by Ed Howard for Banjo Farms of Willowdale.

Trotting star Billyjojimbob returned to his winning form in the \$25,000 free for all on October 18. Billyjo, who disappointed his legion of backers when he went off stride in the October 9 Breeders Crown championship, was never threatened

in stopping the clock in 1:58 1/5 for newly appointed driver Paul MacDonell. Now with 17 wins in 22 tries, Billyjo's season earnings are closing in on \$500,000.

Milton residents Joe Stutzman and Mike Saftic combined for a hat-trick on the Oct. 16 card of racing. Saftic was in the sulky for wins with Keyler Hanover, Monkey business and No Caveats. The trio are all managed by Stutzman.
