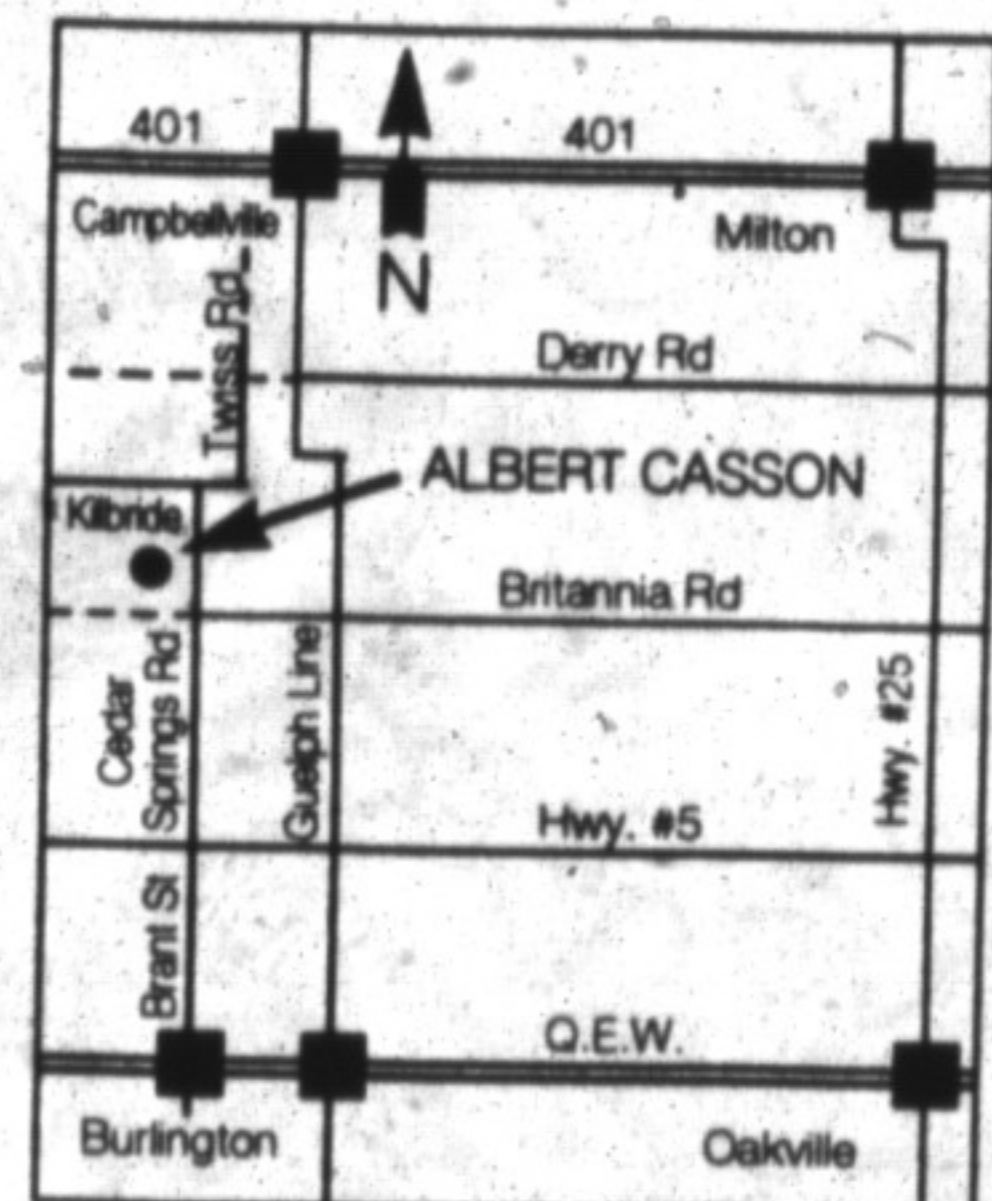


## "Circles"
