Children's treatment centre opens tomorrow

The new Children's Assessment and Treatment Centre (CATC) will officially open in Burlington Thursday.

The Pearl Street treatment centre for children with emotional difficulties, which also has a location in Milton, will be open to the public.

"Recent incidences in the Burlington area are making the public more and more aware of the need for intervention for the estimated one in five children between the ages of 4 to 16 who will at one time or another experience a serious psychiatric disorder," said Fran Caron, CATC's director of development.

CATC got its start at the Joseph Brant Hospital in 1974 when a group of concerned professionals and community representatives saw an urgent need for help for young children experiencing emotional difficulties.

In the late fall of 1990, CATC embarked on its biggest challenge ever — finding a new home for its Burlington clinic, regional administration offices, and other programs. Its previous location had become totally inadequate for the expanding organization.

With a grant from the provincial government and a long-term lease arrangement with the Burlington Central Lions Club, CATC undertook a fundraising campaign for the building of a new clinic in Lions Park in Burlington.

CATC is the only multi-disciplinary, non-residential service in Halton for children 2 to 17 years of age. All aspects of the child are evaluated.

"The uniqueness of the new facility," pointed out Ms Caron, "is that it's an example of the positive results when government, business, and the community work together."

"Not only does CATC have a new home, but the Burlington (Central) Lions Club has a lovely new hall which it rents to the community at very reasonable rates.

"The Burlington Bereavement Council and the Burlington Chapter of the Ontario Friends of Schizophrenics also have space in the new building."
