## Local coin designer honoured at Canadian Mint exhibit opening

Local artist David Craig had an enriching experience recently when he was honoured, along with 17 other Canadian artists by the Royal Canadian Mint.

The artists' works were recognized at the official opening of The Art of the Coin exhibit at Roy Thomson Hall. The display features artists' original sketches that have appeared on coins including four of Mr. Craig's designs.

He's responsible for the illustration on the Royal Canadian Mint's gold \$100 coin commemorating Sainte-Marie Among the Hurons; the 1984 silver dollar commemorating the 150th anniversary of Toronto and promotional paintings used in the campaign for the Mint's 1984 Jacques Cartier commemorative coin.

In 1986 he designed a medallion for Molson Breweries' 200th anniversary. More than 200 of his illustrations were exhibited at the O'Keefe Centre in

Toronto when he was invited to put on a retrospective of his work in 1987.

According to a Royal Canadian Mint press release, Mr. Craig sees himself as an artist who enjoys designing and painting "in a non-commercial way". He is currently working on private and corporate paintings and portraits as well as a series of paintings for the limited edition market.

One of his most recent projects was a painting for the Conn Smythe Sports Celebrities Dinner, depicting the Canadian gold and silver Olympic medal winners at the 1988 Olympic Games.

His background includes formal training at the Ontario College of Art and experience as a graphic illustrator for advertising agencies in Montreal and Toronto after graduation between 1967 and 1974.

In 1976 Mr. Craig opened his own studio and began a freelance career.

His work includes designing posters, book covers, magazine illustrations, paintings and illustrations for just about every major publisher and various corporations in Canada, the press release stated.

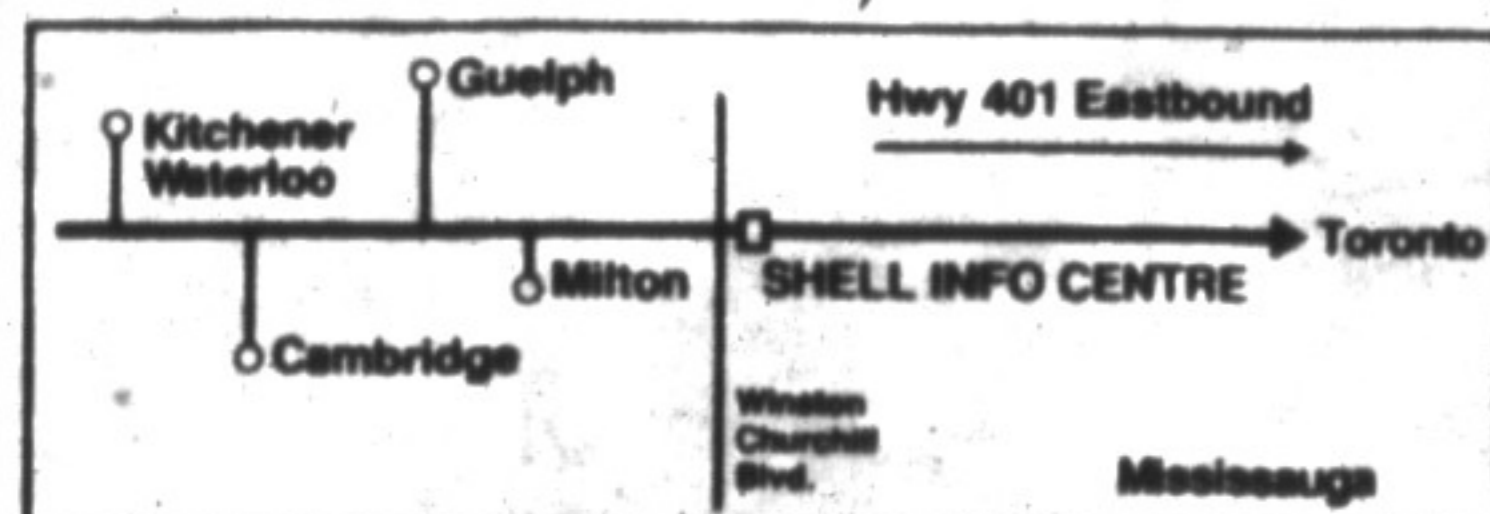
