Diabetes campaign aims to raise \$5,000

Expect a knock on your door from a Canadian Diabetes Association volunteer this month.

November is Diabetes Month, the organization's major fundraising and awareness campaign.

The money will support diabetes research, education programs, and summer camps for kids with the disorder, said Marie McGuffie, organizer of the Milton campaign.

While local canvassers collected \$4,100 last November, this year's goal is \$5,000.

At one time, diabetes meant certain death for millions around the globe until 1921 when Canadian doctors Banting and Best discovered insulin.

Because diabetics lack or are unable to properly use insulin, a hormone produced by the pancreas, they have problems using energy from the foods they eat.

When the body's cells do not get enough insulin, blood sugar and fat levels increase and the body's protein breaks down, setting off chemical changes that produce the symptoms of diabetes.

The disease can slowly damage many of the body's systems. Diabetics are prone to eventually develop blindness, kidney failure, and heart disease.

Some people with what's known as Type One diabetes, must take daily injections of insulin to stay alive, while others with Type Two manage the condition by closely following a diet and exercise regime and taking oral medication.
