### Mill Pond Reconstruction Underway

No doubt you have noticed the orange fencing, new sidewalk, mound of earth and stone slabs surrounding the Mill Pond over the past few weeks. They, along with the PRIDE sign, show the extent of the progress in beautification plans for Centennial Park.

By years end (December 31, 1992) all work will be complete in Centennial and Livingston Parks which surround the pond. The Mill Pond Steering Committee will continue their work on improvements to the whole area around the Mill Pond including the Rotary Park and the pond itself.

#### CENTENNIAL PARK will feature:

- · large slab stone treatment along waters edge
- · interlocking brick walkways connnecting areas
- · low shrub bed with annual planting for colour
- · dark hunter green fencing, benches and decorative lighting
- resodding of park

#### LIVINGSTON PARK will feature:

- · New trail through the wooded area north of the pond (funded by the Milton Jaycees)
- New sidewalk into park from Martin Street
- Addition of lights on trail
- Historical rose garden on hill at John Martin House
- Seating area at pond edge for skaters
- Lookout at the promontory
- Lit parking area

The Mill Pond Steering Committee will continue to over the next two years to make improvements to the Old Historical Milton Neighbourhood.


