"He kind of walked in the room and you knew he was there," said Sherry Logue, Mr. Smith's commonlaw wife. The couple had been together for five years.

Mr. Smith was killed after being run over by his own vehicle on Highway 6 in Flamborough. On his way home from work, he stopped his van on the shoulder of the road to talk to a co-worker travelling behind him.

He was walking at the rear of the van when he slipped on some slush. At the same time, the vehicle, which had not been properly secured in parking gear, moved backwards and ran over him.
