Recovering from crash

An 18-year-old Oakville man remains in serious but stable condition in hospital following Tuesday morning's two-car crash on Ninth Line.

Mark Sanders was driving his Ford Escort northbound on Ninth Line, just north of Lower Base Line, when he lost control of the vehicle in the snow, Halton police said.

The vehicle crossed into the path of a southbound mini-van and was struck on the side.

The sole passenger of the Escort, Ian Richardson, 19, also of Oakville, is in good condition at Credit Valley Hospital. Mr. Sanders was transferred to Mississauga hospital.

The driver of the van, Peter Davies, 34, and his one-year-old daughter Britney, both of Georgetown, were treated in hospital for minor injuries and released.

The accident is under investigation. No charges have been laid.
