Halton councillors opt to pay themselves more

Halton regional council overturned a committee decision to freeze politicians' salaries Wednesday, opting instead for a one per cent retroactive raise in December, 1991 and one per cent again next month.

Last week the regional administrative and finance committee, after much discussion, decided to hold the line at the current stipend of \$18,337. But this week, after considerable debate, councillors voted themselves two annual raises, roughly \$183 and \$185. Only seven councillors out of 24 supported the freeze.

Burlington councillor Doug Greenaway indicated he had been frustrated with Halton's inability to freeze employee wages across the board, as well as council stipends.
