Officially donating the piano, a ribbon-cutting ceremony was held at the Nassagaweya Women's Institute Homefest craft show Saturday.

Mr. Henderson told the crowd his family sold the old piano to the original Brookville Hall in 1937.

Also on hand were councillors Barry Lee and Marion Howard, as well as Glenda Benton, president of the Halton District Women's Institute and Institute representatives from Campbellville, Dublin, and Wellington.

Anne Flemming-Read of Campbellville, a college piano teacher who was instrumental in obtaining the piano for the women's institute, was another special guest.

A short piano recital by local pianists Donna Manes, Mrs. Blacklock, and Eileen McEnery, and with Ernie McEnery on the fiddle, wrapped up the ceremony.

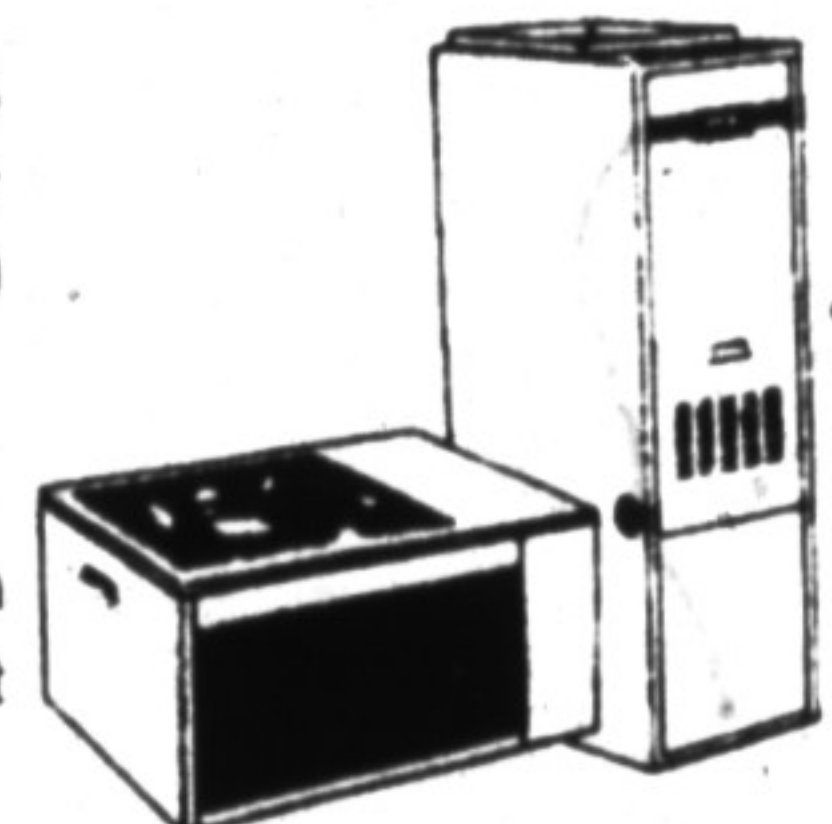
