**Complex preparation**

**Glen Eden tuned up for ski season**

With the first snowfall behind us and cool November weather upon us, skiers thoughts turn to purchasing new equipment.

This usually will mean shopping around and looking at different models, trying on different sizes and making that important selection. Now the skier is ready for the slopes but ski resort operators are faced with more complex preparations for the season.

Before the lifts start running, the resort has to have its marketing in order. The task of producing brochures is usually completed in the heat of mid-July. Timing is important as there are always

revisions which have to be made to have it ready for mid-September.

Rental equipment has to be upgraded on a regular basis to ensure skiing safety and quality, another major pre-season chore. Manufacturers must receive orders in April and in some cases sales

staff are out in force while the last days of spring skiing are still being enjoyed.

The extensive maintenance required by the lift equipment is necessary to meet safety standards and to reduce down time once the season gets rolling. Work begins on mechanical components in the summer while electrical switch gears and relays are given a thorough check in October.

With the snow hinting at the ski season to come, resorts are well prepared for that first day of skiing. They've been gearing up since the last skiers left the slopes in the spring.

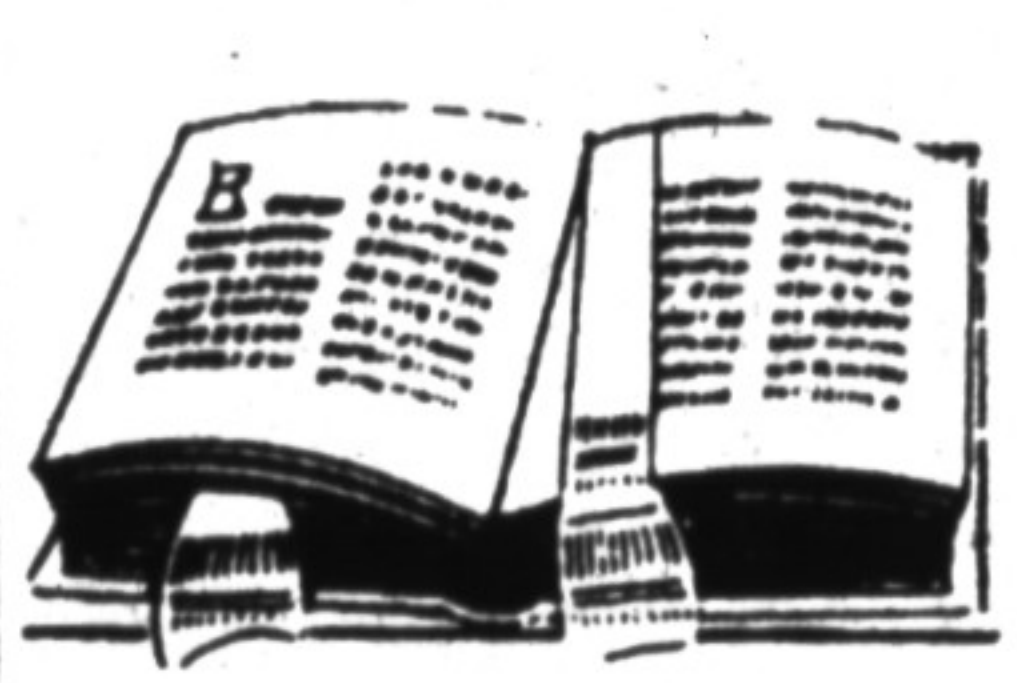
