# Be safe stay well away from fallen wires

Ice storms, high winds, falling tree limbs can bring hydro lines down. Don't go near a fallen wire ... even a seemingly dead line can be dangerous. Warn others to keep clear and call Milton Hydro to report the fallen wire.

If the line falls across your vehicle, stay inside until the line is removed by a hydro crew. If you must leave because of fire, jump clear without touching the car and the ground at the same time. If there's a live power line touching your car, putting even one foot on the ground can be a fatal move to make.
