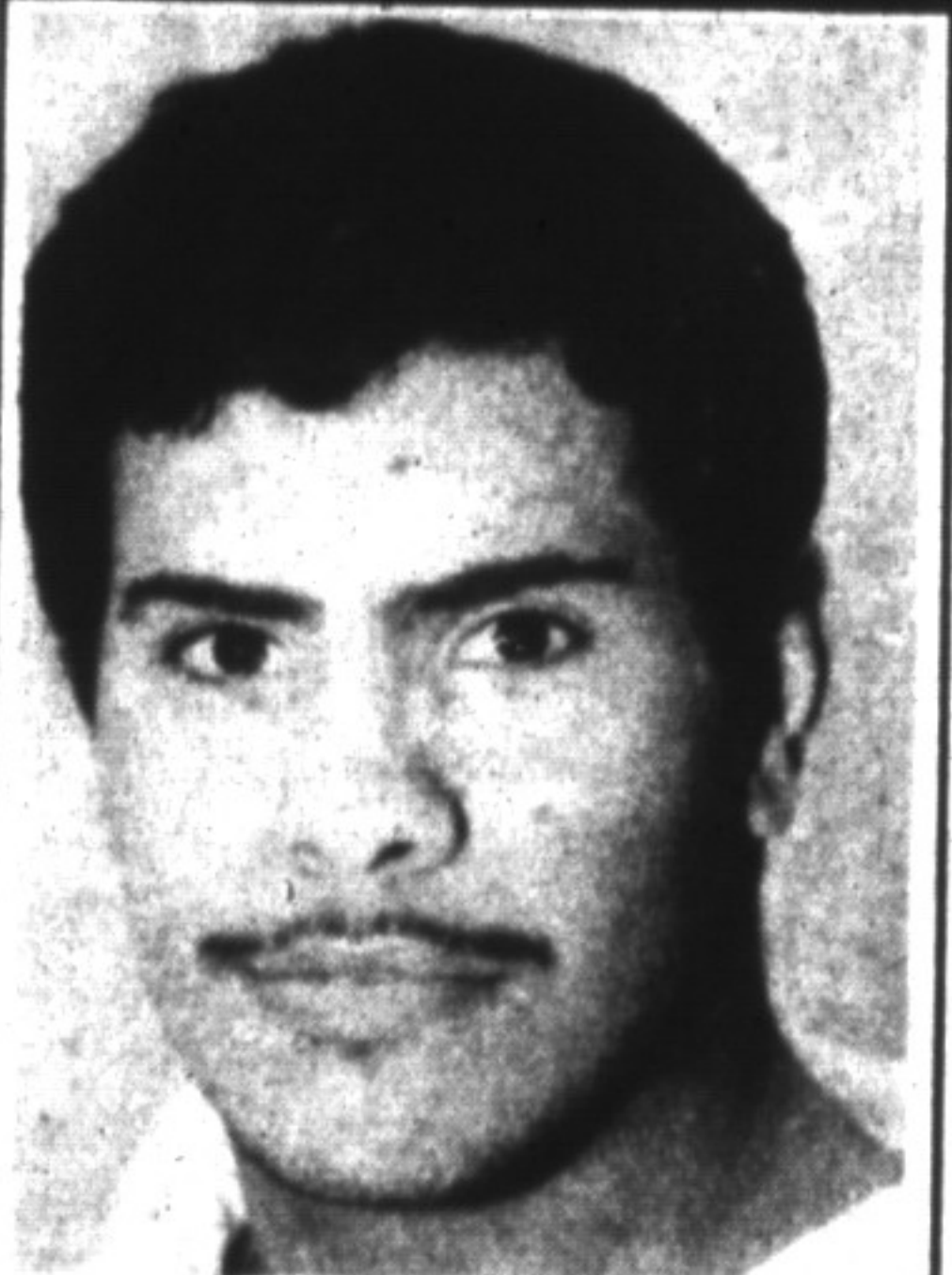
Members benefit from mutual support in their training for specific races and personal goals. A bi-
