Saw a red stripe

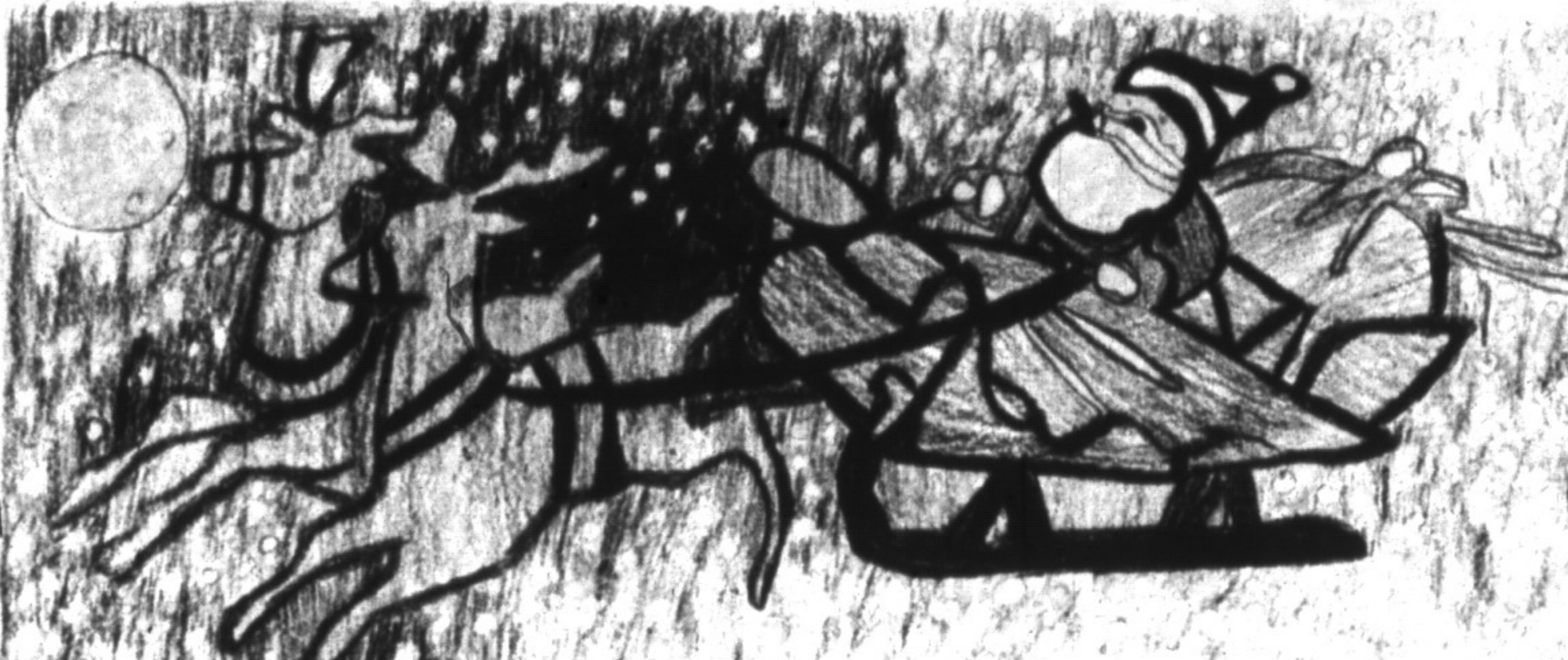
