Police were called to a McNabb Crescent home at 4:30 p.m. after a 42-year-old woman reported that her common-law husband struck her in the face and threatened her 17-yearold daughter.

The man had been drinking and an argument started, police said.

A 37-year-old man faces two counts of assault and a breach of probation charge.
