CRIME STOPPERS OF HALTON

**Woman sexually
assaulted in van**

Halton Regional Police detectives in Oakville and Crime Stoppers are appealing to the public for information that leads to the identities and arrests of three men responsible for sexually assaulting a woman in Oakville.

On Friday, Nov. 13 at 5 p.m., a 26-year-old woman was found by a motorist laying on the south side of Lakeshore Road in the area of Third Line near the boat ramp at Coronation Park.

The woman had been sexually assaulted and dropped by her three assailants at the location.

The victim had left the Burlington Arms beside the Burlington Bowl at Harvester Road and Walkers Line and caught a bus to the GO Station on Harvester Road, just east of Appleby Line.

The victim began hitchhiking and was picked up by three men in a white van with side windows in it. There was also a prominent stripe (possibly green) along the side of the van.

The two suspects in the rear of the van sexually assaulted the woman until she was dropped off along with her clothing at the Lakeshore Road location.

The two suspects in the rear of the van are described as:

1. Male white, in his mid to late thirties, long dirty blond hair, unshaven with a moustache. He was missing a top left front tooth and was wearing jeans and a plaid work shirt.

2. Male white, 40 to 50 years of age, long dark scruffy hair, and unshaven.

If you have any information that leads to an arrest in this or any other case, you may be eligible for a cash reward of up to \$1,000. You need not give your name and your information will be treated with complete anonymity. Please call 1-800-668-5151 or 825-TIPS (That's 825-8477).

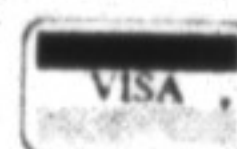
