## Group sessions for abused and abusers

COHR Family Services is offering group sessions for women who have been abused, men who are abusers, and care givers of the elderly.

A free group starts January 26 for women who have been or are being abused by their male partner. The same program is offered for women aged over 55 years, which starts February 24.

A small fee will be charged to attend a series of three weekday information sessions for women who think they may be being abused, to learn about abuse, resources, and options.

An ongoing counselling group for men who have assaulted their female partners takes place Wednesday evenings from 7-9 p.m. A small fee is required.

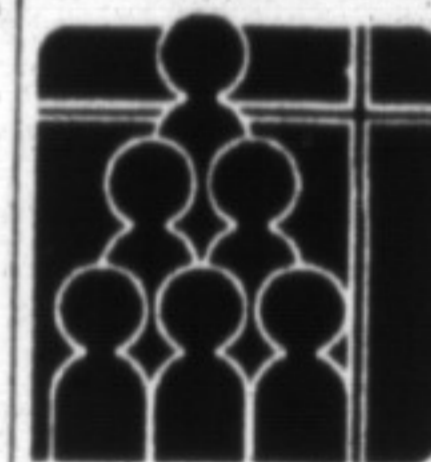
