Board budget task force runs into road block

Halton Board of Education director Bob Williams' proposed 1994 budgetary task force hit snag Monday night.

The task force failed to receive approval in principle from the board's 1993 finance committee when a Burlington trustee complained she had not yet received information she had requested a month ago.

The formation of the task force has been billed as the vehicle which can change the board's budget process and format to achieve expenditure budget (not millrate) increases at 0 per cent in 1994 (a municipal election year) and increases at or below the inflation rate in 1995 and 1996.

At Monday night's finance committee meeting, trustees were asked to support the task force in principle so Mr. Williams could outline the mandate, terms of reference and action plan for the task force.

But Burlington trustee Anne Barbu claimed she had not yet received information about the mandate and terms of reference of the task force which she had requested a month ago. Mr. Williams said he couldn't remember her making the request.

Ms Barbu said she didn't want to approve in principle something without knowing its terms of reference or mandate.

Trustees became confused and somewhat split on whether the task force should be approved before its terms of reference or after, particularly when finance committee chair Don Cassidy ruled in favour of Ms Barbu — delaying voting on the item until she had received her information.

That opened a challenge of the chair by several trustees and saw a vote taken upholding Mr. Cassidy's decision. The debate and voting was shelved for now.

The task force would consist of board and staff groups working to change the budget process, budget document and develop a budget priority list so wherever the 0 per cent increase line is drawn, priorities above the line would be funded, those below would not be.

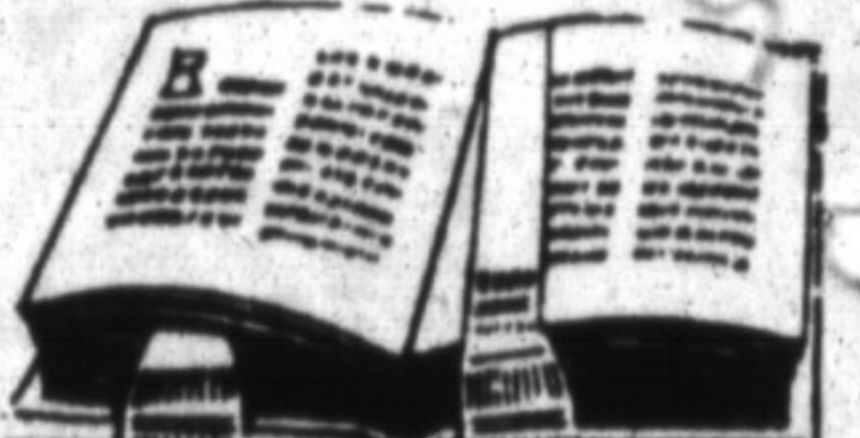
