

Nomination meeting set for federal Liberal party

The nomination meeting to select the Oakville-Milton federal Liberal candidate will take place Wednesday, Apr. 7 at St. Vlodymyr Cultural Centre, 1280 Dudas St. Oakville.

Under new party rules, cut-off for recruitment of new members eligible to vote, occurred February 5 and 1992 members had until March 5 to renew.

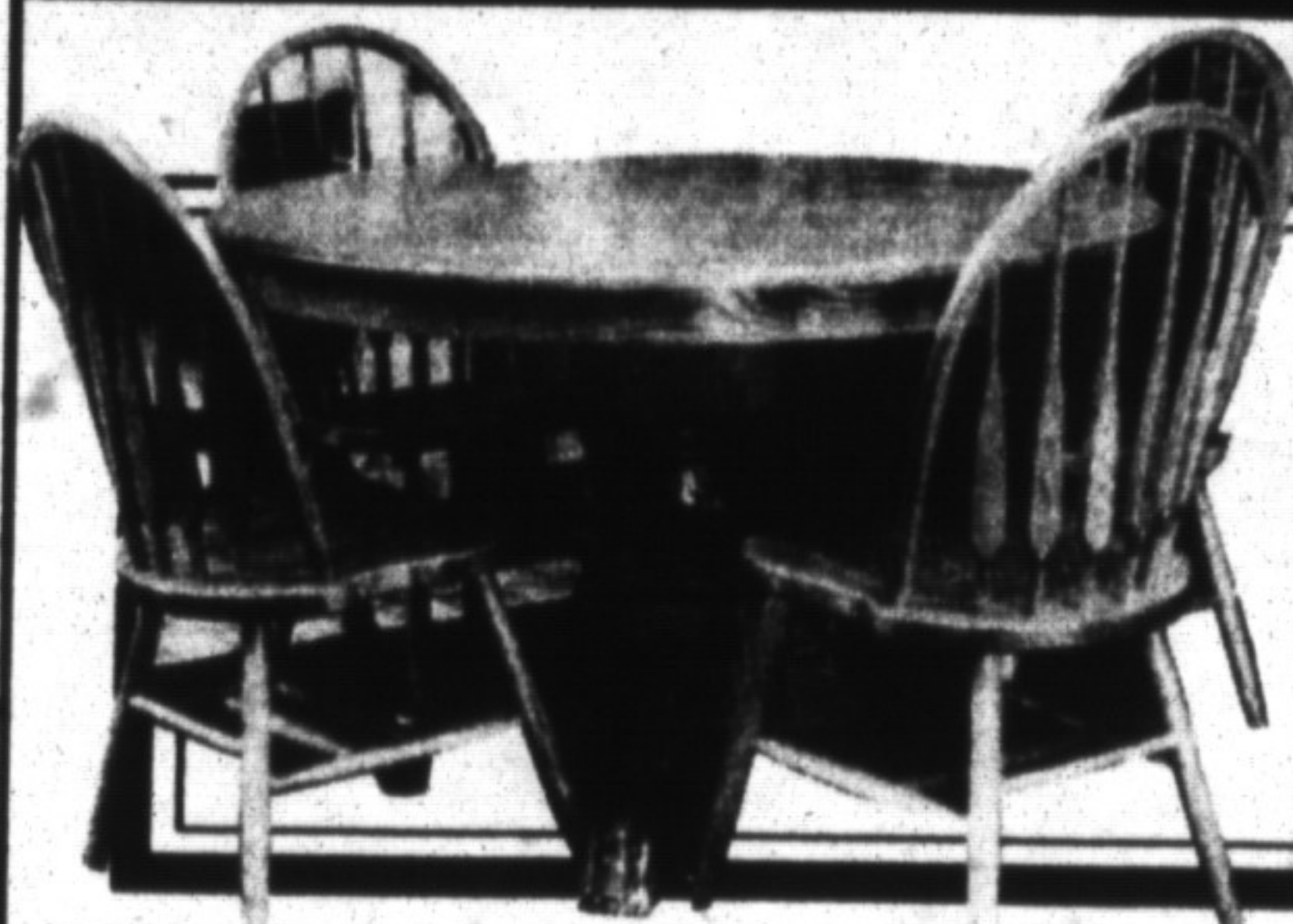

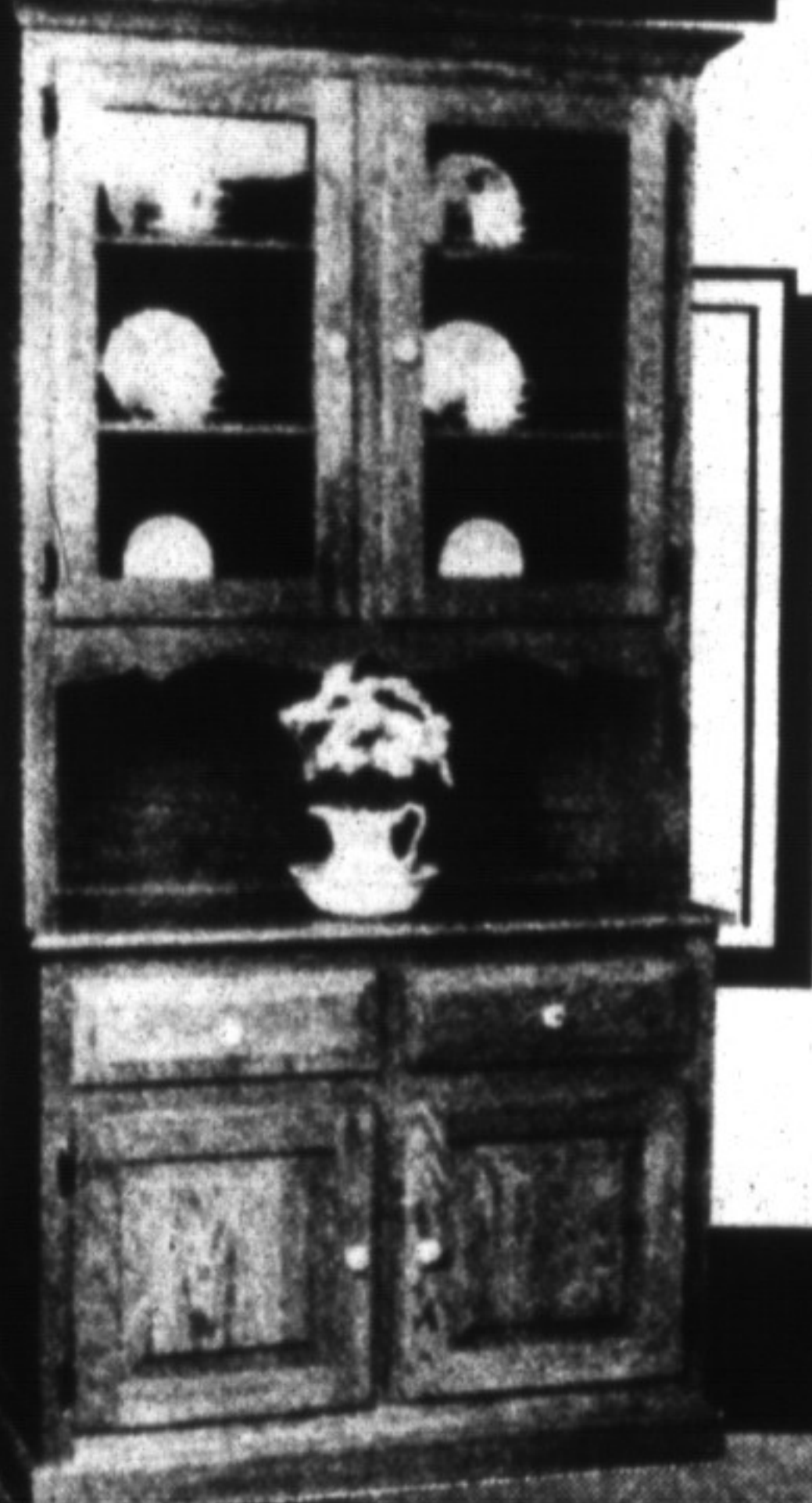
