## Date violence seen through 'Mirror Game' at E.C. Drury

When the Young People's Theatre production of the *Mirror Game* came to E. C. Drury High School, the audience initially treated the visit as another chance to get out of class.

But that quickly changed with the harsh reality presented in the play. The production explores violence in teenage dating. The *Mirror Game* can, at times, be blunt in its message.

Students sat in silence when Luke, a handsome athletic student strikes his attractive girlfriend, Sara. Throughout the play, Sara hides the problem, thinking that Luke loves her, and he just gets angry sometimes. Compounding the situation is the constant arguing of Luke's parents and the fact his father hits his mother.

Sara denies there is a problem until her two friends, Maggie and Bobby, begin to see the signs. Tired being scared and beaten, Sara admits Luke's problem to Maggie. The play ends with optimism. Maggie convinces Sara to leave Luke. After months of harassment, and calls to the police, Luke is leaving her alone, and Sara is starting to feel comfortable again.

All four of the characters in the play experience some sort of psychological or physical abuse at home.

The parents of the characters are seen only as shadows, but their personalities are vividly captured. This technique also shows the negative effect they are having on their children's personalities.

The play was written by Vancouver's Dennis Foon, after he saw girls in need in Vancouver schools. The coordinators of the play were overwhelmed by the popularity of the production by educators, returning to schools for another run.

In Canada, one in five women are sexually assaulted in some way in their lifetime. A woman is sexually assaulted, involving forced sexual intercourse, every 17 minutes in Canada.

A number of sexual offences are now considered a form of assault. A sexual assault can include conduct ranging from an unwanted touching of the breasts or buttocks, to forced sexual intercourse.
