It looks as if Milton video stores that provide sexually explicit tapes will pay a little more for doing so soon. And it also appears anyone planning to open a full-fledged adult video store in town will be put through a public wringer.

Last Tuesday night town council's general committee tightened local bylaws relating to adult video outlets and stores offering small adult viewing sections.

Several Milton video rental shops have areas portioned off which contain adult sex tapes. Councillors supported a plan to see the stores charged some sort of fee for doing so, probably around \$100 a year.

On a larger but currently more remote scale, councillors also laid plans to make it more difficult for anyone hoping to open a wholly sex-oriented video rental establishment in Milton.

Councillors plan to amend the existing land use bylaw to limit the areas where such an outlet could do business. Milton is not legally able to exclude sex video stores from locating in town, but the mechanism can be created to only allow them in certain areas.

Under the currently contemplated measures, someone hoping to operate a sex video store would have to apply for a zoning amendment to gain council approval.

Part of the zoning amendment process is a public hearing, which, according to town bylaw enforcement officer Bill Bamford, "might discourage" potential applicants.

Anti sex-video representatives have appeared in front of town council before, and obtained support.

The licencing fee for an adult video outlet will rise from the current \$250 to \$1,000 annually with the new bylaws.

In researching the bylaw proposals, Mr. Bamford studied related legislation in Burlington. Burlington charges \$85 annually as a fee to video stores that provide some adult video tapes, and limits the proportion of them to 10 of every 100 videos in the store.
