

Sex abuse trial postponed

A sex abuse trial involving a deaf school counsellor and three former female students has been postponed for a week. The Milton general division court trial has been put over until Monday.

The case involves three former pupils aged 12, 15, and 17 who, in the fall of 1991, reported being sexually assaulted by an E. C. Drury School for the Deaf residence coun-

sellor during May, 1972 and June, 1980. It's also alleged the counsellor threatened one of the girls with a handgun while sexually assaulting her.

Harvey Bradley, 46, of Merritt Drive, is charged with having sexual intercourse with a female under 16 years of age, two counts of rape, being in possession of a weapon for a purpose dangerous to the public peace, indecent assault, and assault.
