ings larger than 200,000 square feet. Also, the province is investing \$300 million in a small business development program through its new jobsOntario Community Action program, Mr. Duignan pointed out.

Ms Sullivan characterized the entire \$1.1 billion jobsOntario employment creation strategy, of which the new Community Action program is a fledgling component, as "clearly a failure. Governments don't create jobs."

Ms Sullivan, the Liberal health critic, noted that "one of the measures hidden in this budget is that they're going to start charging psychiatric patients" for their treatment. She depicted it as attacking "one of the most vulnerable sectors of the economy."

Mr. Duignan was concerned about the clause, and said he has "asked for clarification" of it.
