Rain held off crowds at fairground events

Rainy weather put a damper on the turnout for a truck pull and demolition derby at the fairgrounds on the weekend, say organizers.

"The weather didn't co-operate, as you know," said Charlie Speck, president of the Halton Agricultural Society which hosted the events. "It scared a lot of people away."

About 400 people, half the number expected, came out Friday night to see a series of truck pulls. All out-of-towners took home the prizes trophies.

Saturday night's demolition derby drew a bigger crowd. About 800 spectators witnessed five heats.

Truck pull: Steve Whitelaw of Palmerston (stock truck); Lynden Gibson of Fergus (6,000 lb street legal); Wayne Clifford of Peterborough (6,500 lb street legal); and Gary McSweeney of Newcastle (highway tractor).
