

Pair charged with assault after attack

A youth and a man, both from Milton, face assault charges after a man was jumped from behind, outside a downtown dance club.

Two people punched a 21-year-old Childs Drive man in the face and kicked him when he fell to the ground at 1:50 a.m. June 20. He suffered a broken nose and two black eyes. A youth, 17, and a man, 19, were charged with assault.

Truck stolen

Halton police believe a truck stolen from a Main Street East company was used in a break-in at an Ontario Hydro compound over the weekend.

Thieves stole copper wire, a generator and two gas-powered water pumps from the Main Street and Fourth Line compound.

That same weekend, a blue and white Ford van worth \$8,000 was stolen from Scannell Moving and Storage. Nothing was taken other than the vehicle, and no attempt was made to enter the building, police

said. Detective Sergeant Mike Kingston said there's a "strong possibility" the two break-ins are related.

Rash of house break-ins
Halton police believe the same people are responsible for a series of break-ins at Milton homes.

Break-ins were reported June 21, 23, 24 and 28 at Milton homes on Townline, Twiss Road, No. 30 Sideroad, No. 10 Sideroad, and Highway 25.

A resident arrived home during one of the break-ins and spotted a van in her driveway. She went to a neighbour's house to call police, but the vehicle was gone soon after.

The thieves were after valuable such as televisions, video cassette recorders, video cameras, jewellery and cash. Frozen meat was even stolen from one home.
