Blanche branching out in retirement

To Blanche Hinton, retirement doesn't mean relaxing summers at the cottage and winters in Florida.

In fact, the longtime Ernest C. Drury School for the Deaf teacher will be more active than usual, travelling across Canada and overseas.

After almost three decades of teaching business to deaf students, Ms Hinton, 55, is retiring. She will instead focus her efforts on her own business — starting a tour company.

"I've been there 26 years. It's time for a change," she told *The Champion* during her final day on the job last Wednesday.

What will she miss the most? "The kids," Ms Hinton said instantly. She described working with deaf children as "satisfying."

Besides teaching business, she has been valuable to the school in other capacities, most recently as a drama teacher. Under her direction, students won several awards for an opera they performed at the last Sears Drama Festival.

"I've been involved with every committee that existed at that place," she said when asked about her participation in school activities outside the classroom.

She is known among her colleagues as "extremely active and highly respected," said Paul Bartu, superintendent of the school for the deaf.

Students think of her as a "strict disciplinarian" and she demands a high level of performance. They also respect her fairness and honesty, said Mr. Bartu.

Fluent in five languages, Ms Hinton has been, and continues to be, an asset to the Milton community which became her home 19 years ago. In 1978, she entered local

politics, serving as a town councillor until 1985.

The former legal secretary is currently a member of the Rotary Club and is responsible for starting a deaf student exchange program — the only one of its kind in the world.

Eight years ago, she founded Milton Arts Productions and is on the board of directors of the Milton Horticultural Society and the Mississauga City Centre Opera.

A native of London, England, Ms Hinton came to Canada when she was 18 years old.

She first lived in Georgetown, but soon moved to Toronto. She's divorced and has three sons aged 26, 31 and 33.

Ms Hinton's life will now turn toward her business venture. Her love for travel prompted her to seek a career in the world of tourism. In

her own business, she plans trips for people and will act as a guide on Canadian and European excursions.

And she's on her way already. Next week she will lead a bus tour across the country.
