Seize stuff worth \$100 million

Horsemen corral more heroin

Milton's RCMP drug section has seized more than \$100 million worth of heroin in connection with an importation scheme from Thailand to Toronto.

The high-grade Southeast Asian drugs were hidden in picture frames transported from Lester B. Pearson shipped by air in two large crates destined to a Euclid Avenue address in Toronto, RCMP officials say.

The local drug team, assisted by Canada Customs, allowed the heroin- chocked frames to enter the country under close surveillance, according to the RCMP.

On August 17, the shipment was Airport to a Scarborough hotel,

where it was unpacked. Police seized it during the early morning hours the next day.

A 24-year-old Toronto man and a 30-year-old Markham man face charges of conspiracy to import heroin, conspiracy to traffic, and importing and possession for the purpose of trafficking. The investigation is continuing.

Earlier this month, the drug section seized \$13 million in heroin, which was found by Revenue Canada customs officers concealed in a container of metal bolts.

The shipment originated in Bangkok, Thailand and was destined from Vancouver to a Dundas Street West address in Toronto. Two Toronto men were charged.
