1993 (MORNING) SPECIAL BUS ROUTES (SCHOOL)

NOTE: Students for E. C. Drury High School from the Dorset Park area will take the Yellow Route Bus and disembark at the Milton Mall. The afternoon pick-up from E. C. Drury High School to Dorset Park will continue as in the past. Students from the Dorset Park area who travel to Milton District High School will travel on a special bus which will follow the following route:

THE BUS WILL STOP AT THE DESIGNATED STOPS ONLY

BUS NO. 1

TO: MILTON DISTRICT HIGH SCHOOL — 7:50 a.m. from Lorne Scots Drive at Wilson Drive. Bus stops only at the following locations: (1) Lorne Scots Drive at Wilson Drive (2) Lorne Scots Drive at Trafalgar Court (3) Lorne Scots Drive at Woodward Avenue (4) Joyce Boulevard at McNabb Crescent (5) Joyce Boulevard at Elliott Crescent (6) Joyce Boulevard at Wilson Drive (7) Woodward Avenue at Briar Crescent (8) Woodward Avenue at Maple Avenue (9) Maple Avenue at Cedarbrae Avenue (10) Thompson Road at walkway north of Main Street. The bus will then proceed to Milton District High School (stop on Commercial Street).

TO: SAM SHERRATT SCHOOL — 8:15 a.m. from Laurier Avenue and Commercial Street. West on Laurier Avenue to Farmstead Drive. South on Farmstead Drive to Derry Road. West on Derry Road to Bronte Street. North on Bronte Street to Vanier Drive. Along Vanier Drive to Laurier Avenue. East on Laurier Avenue to Ontario Street. South on Ontario Street to Derry Road. East on Derry Road to Holly Avenue. North on Holly Avenue to Sam Sherratt School. (Arrival at 8:30 a.m.)

BUS NO. 2

TO: BISHOP REDING HIGH SCHOOL — (from Timberlea Area) — 7:55 a.m. from Laurier Avenue at Holly Avenue. Bus stops only at: (1) Laurier Avenue and Holly Avenue (2) Cox's Boulevard and Pearen Avenue (arrival at Bishop Reding 8:05 a.m.) At 8:05 a.m., the bus will go directly to Lorne Scots Drive and Wilson Drive with no stops.

TO: W. I. DICK SCHOOL — 8:10 a.m. from Lorne Scots Drive at Wilson Drive. Bus stops only at: (1) Lorne Scots Drive at Wilson Drive (2) Lorne Scots Drive at Trafalgar Court (3) Lorne Scots Drive at Woodward Avenue (4) Joyce Boulevard at McNabb Crescent (5) Joyce Boulevard at Elliott Crescent (6) Joyce Boulevard at Wilson Drive (7) Woodward Avenue at Briar Crescent (8) Woodward Avenue at Maple Avenue (9) Maple Avenue at Cedarbrae Avenue (10) Woodward Avenue at McNaughton Court. The bus will then proceed West on Woodward Avenue, across Ontario Street to Elm Avenue. Elm Avenue to Highside Drive to W.I. Dick (Arrival 8:25 a.m.)

BUS NO. 3

TO: W. I. DICK SCHOOL (AND HOLY ROSARY SCHOOL) — 7:55 a.m. from Laurier Avenue at Farmstead Drive. West on Laurier Avenue to Vanier Drive. North on Vanier Drive to Meadowbrook Drive. North on Meadowbrook Drive to Heslop Road. East on Heslop Road to Bell Street. North on Bell Street to Main Street. East on Main Street to Martin Street. North on Martin Street to Woodward Avenue. East on Woodward Avenue to Holy Rosary School Entrance. (Arrival at 8:10 a.m.) East from Holy Rosary School Entrance to Elm Avenue. North on Elm Avenue to Highside Drive. West on Highside Drive to W.I. Dick School (Arrival 8:15 a.m.)

TO: MILTON DISTRICT HIGH SCHOOL — 8:20 a.m. from Martin Street at Woodward Avenue. North on Martin Street to Kings Court to Kingsleigh Court. Around Kingsleigh Court to Glenn Crescent to Steeles Avenue. East on Steeles Avenue to Ontario Street. South on Ontario Street to Mountainview Drive. West on Mountainview Drive to Elm Avenue. South on Elm Avenue to George Street. East on George Street to Ontario Street. South on Ontario Street to Main Street. West on Main Street to Commercial Street. South on Commercial Street to Milton District High School. (Stop on Commercial Street) (Arrival 8:35 a.m.)

NOTE: The Halton Board of Education and the Halton Separate School Board both provide transportation service for students who live a certain distance away from the school they are attending. Please check with your School Board if you have any questions.

Bus stops only at: (1) Lorne Scots Drive at Wilson Drive (2) Lorne Scots Drive at Trafalgar Court (3) Lorne Scots Drive at Woodward Avenue (4) Joyce Boulevard at McNabb Crescent (5) Joyce Boulevard at Elliott Crescent (6) Joyce Boulevard at Wilson Drive (7) Woodward Avenue at Briar Crescent (8) Woodward Avenue at Maple Avenue (9) Maple Avenue at Cedarbrae Avenue (10) Woodward Avenue at McNaughton Court. At this point, the bus will travel directly to W.I. Dick School.

FROM: W.I. DICK SCHOOL TO DORSET PARK — 3:25 p.m. from Lorne Scots Drive at Wilson Drive. Bus stops only at: (1) Lorne Scots Drive at Woodward Avenue (2) Joyce Boulevard at McNabb Crescent (3) Joyce Boulevard at Elliott Crescent (4) Joyce Boulevard at Wilson Drive (5) Woodward Avenue at Briar Crescent (6) Woodward Avenue at Maple Avenue (7) Maple Avenue at Cedarbrae Avenue (8) Woodward Avenue at McNaughton Court.

BUS NO. 2

FROM: BISHOP REDING HIGH SCHOOL TO TIMBERLEA — 3:10 p.m. from Bishop Reding High School. South on Thompson Road to Childs Drive. Bus stops only at: (1) Cox's Boulevard and Pearen Avenue (2) Laurier Avenue and Holly Avenue. The bus will then proceed directly to E.C. Drury High School.

FROM: E.C. DRURY HIGH SCHOOL TO DORSET PARK — 3:35 p.m. from E.C. Drury High School. Bus stops only at: (1) Lorne Scots Drive at Wilson Drive (2) Lorne Scots Drive at Trafalgar Court (3) Lorne Scots Drive at Woodward Avenue (4) Joyce Boulevard at McNabb Crescent (5) Joyce Boulevard at Elliott Crescent (6) Joyce Boulevard at Wilson Drive (7) Woodward Avenue at Briar Crescent (8) Woodward Avenue at Maple Avenue (9) Maple Avenue at Cedarbrae Avenue (10) Thompson Road at walkway north of Main Street. At this point, the bus will travel directly to Milton District High School.

Bus stops only at: (1) Lorne Scots Drive at Wilson Drive (2) Lorne Scots Drive at Trafalgar Court (3) Lorne Scots Drive at Woodward Avenue (4) Joyce Boulevard at McNabb Crescent (5) Joyce Boulevard at Elliott Crescent (6) Joyce Boulevard at Wilson Drive (7) Woodward Avenue at Briar Crescent (8) Woodward Avenue at Maple Avenue (9) Maple Avenue at Cedarbrae Avenue (10) Thompson Road at walkway north of Main Street.

BUS NO. 3

FROM: W. I. DICK SCHOOL (HOLY ROSARY SCHOOL) TO SOUTHWEST QUADRANT AND TIMBERLEA — 3:20 p.m. from W. I. Dick School. West on Highside Drive to Mountainview Drive to Woodward Avenue. West on Woodward Avenue to Martin Street (Holy Rosary students to be picked up here at 3:25 p.m.). South on Martin Street to Mill Street. West on Mill Street to Elizabeth Street. South on Elizabeth Street to Main Street. East on Main Street to Bell Street. South on Bell Street to Heslop Road. West on Heslop Road to Meadowbrook Drive. South on Meadowbrook Drive to Vanier Drive. South on Vanier Drive to Laurier Avenue. (3:40 p.m.) The bus will then proceed to Sam Sherratt School.

FROM: SAM SHERRATT SCHOOL TO BRONTE MEADOWS — 3:40 p.m. from Sam Sherratt School. North on Holly Avenue to Laurier Avenue. West on Laurier Avenue to Commercial Street. South on Commercial Street to Derry Road. West on Derry Road to Bronte Street. North on Bronte Street to Vanier Drive. East on Vanier Drive to Laurier Avenue. East on Laurier to Commercial Street. At this point, the bus will travel directly to Milton District High School.

FROM: MILTON DISTRICT HIGH SCHOOL TO NORTHWEST QUADRANT — 4:00 p.m. from Milton District High School (Commercial Street stop). North on Commercial Street to Main Street. West on Main Street to Martin Street. North on Martin Street to Kings Court to Kingsleigh Court. Around Kingsleigh Court to Glenn Crescent. North on Glenn Crescent to Steeles Avenue. East on Steeles Avenue to Ontario Street. South on Ontario Street to Mountainview Drive. West on Mountainview Drive to Riverplace Crescent. South on Riverplace Crescent to Woodward Avenue (end of route).

NOTE: The regular Town Transit System will operate on its regular schedule during the operation of the Special Bus Routes.

REGULAR TRANSIT ROUTE CHANGES

Clements, Hipgrave elected to AMO board

Milton councillor Brad Clements and town chief administrative officer David Hipgrave were elected to the Association of Municipalities of Ontario's (AMO) board of directors at the group's annual meeting held Aug. 23-24 in Hamilton.

Mr. Clements, a regional and local councillor for Ward 2 (urban), will sit on the board of directors as the representative of Zone 4, which includes Halton, Hamilton-Wentworth and Niagara regions. Mr. Hipgrave will be one of only three municipal staff officials from across the province on the board.

"I'm pleased that Milton will be so well represented on the AMO board, as the municipal sector enters into discussions with the government of Ontario over issues that have major impacts on municipalities, including Milton," Mayor Gord Krantz said.

AMO will address in its negotiations with the provincial government over the next year include: the social contract, disentangling responsibilities, welfare reform, provincial subsidies, and economic development.

AMO's primary function is to lobby the provincial government on behalf of its 700 plus member municipalities.
