Girl Guide probes subcontinent

What it's like to ride an elephant is one of the stories Cheryl Poth will tell her classmates when she returns to university this month.

The 20-year-old Milton woman recently returned from a six-week trip to Europe and Asia, which she took through the international Girl Guide event Sangam Adventure II.

With a Guiding colleague from Ottawa, she spent a week in England before arriving in Bombay.

The program "crosses the boundaries of international borders to focus on the friendship of the world," said Barbara Meisner, spokesperson for Girl Guides of Canada.

For Miss Poth, the experience was an eye-opener. "It's hard to imagine we live in the same world," she said.

The culture and lifestyle was quite divergent from Canada's way of living — something she said she never would have truly understood without experiencing it.

"I've travelled to Europe, but this was totally different."

The contrast between the rich and poor was extremely vivid, added Miss Poth.

The excursion was far from just sightseeing. They visited Indian families (many are farmers), 2,000-year-old caves and participated in religious ceremonies.

The people were friendly, and also curious about the western world, she said.

The highlight of the trip was running a children's camp for Indian orphans, Miss Poth said. Through games and other activities, she developed a bond with the eight to 12-year-old children, who cried when it was over.

Miss Poth belongs to Girl Guides as what's called a "link" — she's too old to be a Ranger, but also doesn't have the time to be a leader because she's concentrating on her schooling at Queen's University.

Each year, hundreds of young women from the Girl Guides apply locally for international events. Of those qualified individuals, only a few applications are forwarded to the provincial, and eventually, the national selection committee for consideration.

At the national level, two young women — one Miss Poth — were chosen to represent Canadian Guiding in India at Sangam, one of Guiding's world centres.

India is one of several countries which is home to a Guiding world centre. "This one we don't hear about very often because it's so hard and expensive to get to," she said.
